

What has 1933-34 in store for Football in general and the "Cobblers" Club in particular? This is the thought uppermost in the minds of many thousands of local Soccerites. If we are to judge 1933-34. by the attendances at many of the various practice games there will be larger crowds generally this season than last, and "the depression is likely to fill up." At Northampton the spectators at the two practice games numbered fewer than for many years, but it is believed that the inability to secure a Friday evening was the explanation. Nearly everyone seems to be sure that a large crowd will gather here this evening given suitable weather.

You will wish to begin by recalling the final events of last season. **Brentford** won promotion to Division II., and **Exeter** were runners-

DO YOU RECALL? up, but in the latter case the honour was the sole prize. **Northampton** finished 6th equal

by points (8th if goal average is considered), this good position being largely the result of the home record, which included no defeat. **Luton**, this evening's opponents, were on the 14th rung—not very high. But remember their magnificent Cup performances. They reached the sixth round (their victims including Tottenham Hotspur), and were then beaten by the ultimate winners, **Everton**! **Luton**'s reward is fuller exemption from the earlier Cup rounds this season, and they will enter the competition with the aristocrats in mid-January. Coming back to League matters, the bottom two were **Newport** and **Swindon**, and these successfully applied for re-election. **Clapton Orient** had finished just in front of them by a fraction of a goal! And so the **net change** in the membership of Division III. (S.) is that **Charlton** descend from Division II. and replace **Brentford**.

* * * * *

And let us be clear about other matters which were in doubt during the close season. The proposal to **increase** the number of **Clubs** to be promoted was defeated by 24 votes to 18.

PROPOSALS Its supporters, including Derby County and the **DEFEATED**. Arsenal, were strengthened by a great speech from our **Mr. A. J. Darnell**, who spoke for the Division

III. (S.) clubs. There is little doubt that this alteration can, and should, be achieved. Another proposal that met defeat was the **numbering of players**, and it should be understood that no Soccer club has the power to adopt this innovation. A more important proposal, viz., to admit **Unemployed** at a **6d.** minimum was also lost—not through lack of sympathy, but because of the abuse of the concession where it had been tried. Here again, clubs are not given any option, and this ought to be well known.



—**Crilly, Cherry and Tolland**—are due to play here this evening, and the display of new and old will be keenly followed.

The Luton team is expected to include five new men. **W. Pease** (once our own) and **Martin**, on the right, are from Middlesbrough. **Pearson** (o.l.) from Chelsea, **Gibson** has been a good full back at Sheffield United, and **Mittell** has been understudy to England's goalkeeper (Hibbs) at Birmingham.

Practically a new Cobblers Reserves XI. took the field at Luton this afternoon, where the kick-off was 2.45 p.m., to allow their supporters to then come on to Northampton! Our Reserve players are also hurrying back to see the game here.

An innovation here to-day is the use of **Amplifiers** to broadcast music and announcements. **Messrs. Turner Bros.** are giving a trial demon-

stration, and the co-operation of all spectators is requested. It will be appreciated that the usual collection will be needed, and that to-day's proceedings are an experiment which may or may not be repeated.

Amid the pleasurable hopes for 1933-34, it is right that we should remember that several of the Club's regular attenders have R.I.P. passed over to the Great Beyond during the close season. Among them were two of our gatemen, **J. Eayres** and **F. Warden**, who had given loyal service.—R.I.P.


