LUTON v. ALDERSHOT

Boxing Day.

Aldershot are sure of a very warm welcome this afternoon, for it will be remembered that they accompanied us a long way in the F.A. Cup Competition last season. We managed to go one stage farther, for they were eclipsed at the fifth. Nevertheless, it was a very fine achievement, of which their manager, Mr. Angus Seed, had good reason to be proud, for it was stated that no club in the League had acquired so many good players at so little cost.

Aldershot must be economical of necessity, but the Club is making progress very rapidly, and deserve to do well. At the beginning of the season the team showed one of the finest defences in the country, but has fallen off a little of late. Up to the beginning of this holiday, however, only one team in the Section had fewer goals scored against them than the redoubtable rearguard of Robb, Wade and McDougall.

Most of the team wore the same colours last season, and, writing from memory, we believe Nicol, Easton and Lee are the only recruits included in the selection for to-day. Lee was with Chesterfield last season, and there was something of an outcry when the Derbyshire team allowed him to leave. Easton was with Port Vale, and has recently gained his place in the side.

It is probable, of course, that there may be a few changes in both teams as a result of the two games in three days, but we hope it will not be necessary.

COBBLERS AT LUTON

We have a splendid match as a wind-up for the year next Saturday, when we receive our old friends and rivals, the Cobblers, and we anticipate a really good match. The Cobblers are doing much better now than at the opening of the season, when our lads went to the County ground and won by three goals to two, and they will make a bid to reverse that result.

On Wednesday afternoon we are to have a match that is always enjoyed—the meeting of Luton Boys against Norwich Boys in an English Schools Shield tie. We do hope there will still be good support for the youngsters, and that Luton will pull through to the next round.
