The League—Div. III. LUTON v. QUEEN'S PARK R. Sat., Jan. 20th.

Queen's Park Rangers put up a splendid game on Thursday at Coventry to win by the only goal of the match, and to bring them equal on the average with Norwich City. They are bound to make a tremendous effort to-day to keep that position, and it will be necessary for our lads to pull out as good a game as last Saturday if they are to go near winning.

When we visited the Rangers in September we thought we were rather unfortunate to come away losers by the odd goal of three. We hope to make amends on that to-day, but recognise that it is going to be a stiff business.

We shall be especially pleased to see Mick O'Brien (really, we ought to say Mr. Michael O'Brien now, but it is difficult to do so), and David Richards, manager and trainer respectively of the Rangers.

Their team includes no expensive players, but have the virtue of team spirit and team work, hence their success. According to the selection, Devine will not be playing, and it will be remembered that he was on the injured list when we went to Shepherd's Bush. We should have liked to have seen the old Sunderland player.

Mason is the former Fulham goalkeeper, and Barrie played for West Ham before joining up at Shepherd's Bush last season; Ashman played for Middlesbrough about six seasons before joining the Rangers last season; March was a discovery by the Rangers last season but one; a Dunelmian, Goodier was with Oldham until two seasons ago; and Blake went from Watford at the beginning of this season. Emmerson joined the Rangers this season after a period with Cardiff City, and Eaton also, being transferred from Reading. Blackman is a product of London amateur football, and has been with the Rangers two seasons. Langford was formerly with Leicester City, and Brown had a turn with Rochdale, Sheffield Wednesday and Blyth Spartans before going to Shepherd's Bush.

Our team will be the same as last Saturday, and we hope they will give a big crowd as much pleasure, with a happier result.
