LUTON v. NORWICH.

Sat., Feb. 3rd.

This should be one of the most attractive matches of the programme, for Norwich City are making a tremendous bid for promotion. At the moment they have the lead in the table, but if the Town win this afternoon, the "Canaries" may be relegated to a position below the Rangers.

Consistency has been the keynote of the City, and they are a credit to the work of their manager, Mr. Tom Parker, the former Arsenal captain. Of their thirteen games at home, they have won ten and drawn two, and, extraordinary as it may seem, lost by two goals clear to Torquay. Aldershot and Southend were the two clubs to draw at the Nest. Our team suffered defeat by four goals clear, and will want to avenge that defeat this afternoon. We shall be more than satisfied if they equalise that result, for it will probably mean a further lift on the table for us.

In away games the City have won five and drawn four of thirteen, and their victims include Bournemouth, Bristol City, Crystal Palace, Exeter, and Watford. They made draws at Brighton, Coventry, Northampton and Swindon. That gives an idea of the trouble the Town are up against this afternoon.

The City have a very strong side in the field, and will want to equal their last year's performance, when they took a point away, while our lads are keen on making the most of their outside chance of figuring among the leaders during the closing weeks of the season.

It is unfortunate that Fraser will not be able to take his usual place. The injury he received at Newport was very painful, but he will probably be fit for next Saturday. Joe Rennie is also still unfit, but Brown has invariably risen to the occasion, and we can expect him to do so to-day. This is the only change from the side that won at Newport.

Next Saturday the first team are away to Bristol City, whose Reserves are visiting Luton. The City Reserves have done very well in the Combination this season, and our lads have a little score to wipe off for last season, when the City won at Luton by 6—2. Sammy Weaver will probably be in the City's second string here.

Next Wednesday the replay of the fifth round of the English School Shield between Luton Boys and Watford Boys will be played on our ground, the kick-off being at 3.45. We hope there will be a very big crowd at the game.
