

BRIGHTER PROSPECTS.

The last time I penned some notes for the Club Programme—three weeks ago to be exact—I was in a doleful mood. We had obtained only three points in six matches, scored six goals, and conceded ten. What a happier mood we are all in to-day! Six more points in the locker, ten more goals in the "for" column, and only three given away. And what is more important still—three home matches in hand.

Well Placed.

Look where you like in the League Table and you will not find a club better placed, so far as the possibility of picking up points is concerned, than Gillingham. Not one of the clubs above us have played so many "out" matches or so few at home; only Reading can claim the same number of points from away games, and not one of the Southern Section sides has as good a goal average away from home. A few more "out" victories and a clear record at home—and Second Division Football at Priestfield Road will become more of a reality than it has ever seemed before.

Why not Promotion?

And there is no reason why we should not gain promotion. On current form we have as good a chance as any of the other well-placed clubs. Apart from Coventry City there seems to be no outstanding team this season. And Coventry City have not so good an "away" record as Gillingham. Of course the season is still in its infancy, and there is a long way to go. But points in the locker—and away points at that—count very considerably.

Enthusiasm Needed.

I don't want to be too personal, or to take any liberties, but I would like to stress one point. I take it that every one of you would like to see Second Division Football at Priestfield Road. Well, here is one way to help it to materialise. Come regularly and persuade your friends to attend the home matches. And when the match is in progress give the lads all the encouragement you can. It is wonderful the effect that enthusiastic cheering can have on footballers. Expand your lungs, and I guarantee the boys will repay in full.

The Southern Section Cup.

That Southern Section Cup Competition is becoming a bugbear to the club. Last year, if you remember, full-back Marsden had his nose broken in the first round tie at Priestfield Road. This year there was the unfortunate injury to Turton—curiously enough also playing at right back—and the laying

aside of Duncan. One can hardly expect players to go through a whole season without meeting misfortune of some sort or other, but why it should happen in a match of comparatively little importance fairly beats me. Luck of the game and all that, I suppose, but why *must* it happen to Gillingham? The replay with Exeter City by the way, takes place next Wednesday. Another long journey—and if we win we are booked to travel to the Crystal Palace ground in the next round. Well! Well!

With the Reserves.

The Reserves had matters very much their own way against Tunbridge Wells Rangers, who have now conceded thirteen goals to Gillingham this season. This Kent League victory has got the Reserves in touch with the leaders, and I confidently expect them to "stay put." What a game is in store when Folkestone still going great guns, visit Priestfield Road on November 23rd.


RESIGNATION OF LUTON TOWN MANAGER.






