

WE welcome today, old friends of many a Southern League tussle, Bristol City, and sincerely trust we shall have a continuance of our usual pleasant and thrilling games.

Crystal Palace did us an exceedingly good turn when they knocked the City out of the Cup a fortnight previous—we do not expect for a moment that the City will agree with us on this point—for there was every appearance that we should be without another first team game until Boxing Day. But, alas for the City, and good for us, Fate ruled otherwise.

Bristol City have a very in and out record so far this season and consequently are always likely to spring a surprise. Although having tasted the dregs of defeat at Ashton Gate on three occasions Bristol Rovers and Cardiff City were successful there by two clear goals and Newport County by two goals to one, they have however three away victories and one draw to their credit being the conquerors of Exeter City by one goal to nil, and Watford and Northampton by two goals to nil, whilst forcing a draw of one goal each with Swindon, on these Clubs grounds. It is their defence which makes them such a formidable proposition for of the 21 goals registered against them five came in one match, the Reading forwards being the successful marksman.

Newcomers to the Ashton Gate Club this season are J. Fawkes a full back from Wolverhampton Wanderers, R. Armstrong a half back from Notts Forest and the following forwards, F. McGurk and Joe Bradford from Birmingham, W.

White from Newport County, R. Bungay from Plymouth, J. Randall from Derby County, J. E. Baker from Coventry and H. Turner from Chesterfield.

Last season a drawn game of one goal each resulted from the City's visit, but both clubs will be all out for a definite result today.



CLUB NOTES by "Hatter"

It was a great disappointment last Saturday to all football supporters, especially those in the South of England, when it was found that fog would seriously interfere with the day's sport. Our game at Millwall was no exception to the prevalent weather conditions and not a few were amazed at the match even being played to a finish. The team, due to a exceedingly early start, were successful in arriving at the Den in good time, and three quarters of an hour before the kick off only the dim outline of the goalposts could be seen from the centre line. However the blanket was sufficiently raised for Referee Westwood to decree a commencement at the appointed time, but even then, and it continued so throughout the duration of the game, the fog was sufficient to interfere with the visibility, and consequently wholesale comment on the match is not opportune. Suffice it to say that we had three parts of the game but the shooting of the forwards was rather erratic and no point was notched. On the other hand Millwall found our defence as a rock and accordingly they were unable to notch a point, and so the game ended in a goalless draw. I suppose one would count a point brought away from Millwall as one always well earned, but the balance of play was so much in our favour, that we should have been in a position to have boasted today of having recorded eight successive victories. However the lads have done extremely well and I hope there will be a large crowd to give them a vociferous welcome when they appear today.

Whilst the first team were endeavouring to find the net at the Den, the "Stiffs" found this an easy matter to accomplish at Luton against Brighton Reserves and registered seven without any reply from the seafarers. Harold Andrews headed a brilliant goal after about seven minutes play following a corner kick taken by George Turner and Colin Cook added No. 2 a little later. Before half time two further goals from George Turner and Colin Cook brought the tally to four. Immediately after the resumption George Turner added the fifth and then Bill Thayne scored his usual spectacular goal whilst during the closing stages when a shunting train on the L.M.S. Railway was adding its quota to the fog that had been gradually creeping on, Bill Thayne added a seventh. To comment on the players individually would be superfluous for all played magnificently, team spirit always predominating, but special mention should be made of the display of the two inside forwards Harold Andrews and Frank Beresford. Their manœuvring always had the Brighton defence in a tangle and the result was in no little way due to their craft. The "Stiffs" are to be highly congratulated on their brilliant

displays and Mr. Joe Shaw the Arsenal Assistant Manager told Mr. Jeyes at the Arsenal Stadium last Monday that our team was the best opposition they had met in the Combination this season.

Today we entertain Bristol City and make one change in the team that has been so successful recently. The paucity of goals accruing from a large percentage of the balance of play in preceding matches has given cause for dissatisfaction and accordingly Bill Thayne is being given a chance in the pivotal position. Bill has scored a number of goals for the Reserves. Let us hope he does the same for the first team.

The "Stiffs" visit Queens Park Rangers and have to meet strong opposition, for the Rangers are a greatly improved team. If they can bring anything away with them from the Ellerslie Road ground it will be something well earned. The only change in the team that defeated Brighton so decisively is Jack Ball for Bill Thayne in the centre forward position.

For the benefit of those supporters who were contemplating the journey to Nottingham on Christmas Day, will they please kindly note that the kick-off is 11 a.m.

On Saturday next, we are due at Coventry, the result of which game will have an important bearing on the Championship. I have been informed that the L.M.S. Railway are running special excursions and I expect the Bobbers Stand Club will be doing likewise.
