

Here are the Answers

1. Darlington. During that time they have secured William Allison and George Smith (from Clapton Orient) William Cook and John Alderson (Stoke City) Joseph Ince and Arthur Childs (Exeter City) Donald Ashman and Gordon Reed (Queens Park Rangers) Robert Johnson (Derry City) Thomas Alderson (Luton) John Middleton (Swansea) James Loughlin (Kidderminster Harriers) and John Logan (Charlton Athletic) all of whom are natives of County Durham.

2. When Patrick Corcoran, an outside right, was transferred from Bathgate (Scotland) to Plymouth Argyle in October 1920 he was succeeded in the Bathgate team by David Robbie, who, after a long spell with Bury, joined Plymouth last July, and who is with Manchester United now.

3. Fifteen by Tranmere Rovers who in Northern Section games, beat Rochdale by 9-1 at Birkenhead on Xmas Day 1931 and 6-3 at Rochdale on the Boxing Day.

4. In season 1929-30 William Harthill, Tudor Martin, Thomas Hunt, Francis Hemmingway and Walter Bottrill were the leading League Scorers of Wolverhampton, Newport County, Norwich City, Exeter City and York City respectively and in the following campaign all were at Wolverhampton together.
