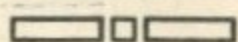

TODAY for the third of our holiday fixtures we return the compliment to our hosts of Friday last, Bristol Rovers, and at the same time accord them a hearty welcome on their visit to Hatopolis.

The Rovers are another Club who have the reputation of doing the unexpected and their record this season only goes to enhance this. At the Eastville ground they have had their colours lowered by Crystal Palace by four goals to two, by Queens Park Rangers and Watford by the only goal of the match and by Reading by four goals to one whilst Bristol City, Cardiff City, Clapton Orient and Notts County have all demanded a share of the spoils. Away from home the Rovers beat their local rivals, Bristol City, by two clear goals and also succeeded at Watford by two goals to one, whilst drawn games resulted from their visits to Cardiff City and Southend United. Their biggest defeats were at Notts County and Aldershot, both teams netting six times whilst Crystal Palace scored five times against them. On the other hand they have scored five goals against Brighton and Northampton.

The Rovers retained eighteen players from the 1934/5 season, but this was reduced by one when they transferred our old player George McNestry to Coventry City. Additions to their ranks include Alfred Robertson the ex-Clapton Orient custodian, Hugh Adcock and Archie Young from Leicester City, Harry Barley a right winger from Scunthorpe, Allan F. Murray a pivot from Fulham, John A. Woodman a centre forward with a goalscoring reputation from the Bristol Melrose Club, Raymond Golledge from Bristol City, George Crisp from Coventry City, Roland Hill a full back from Pontypridd and John Preece another full back from Wolverhampton Wanderers. Shortly after the commencement of the season Harold Houghton, the Norwich City inside forward was secured and only just recently an exchange deal was made with Liverpool whereby the Rovers brilliant young inside forward Philip Taylor joined the Mersey Club and William Harthill, of Wolverhampton fame made the trek south.

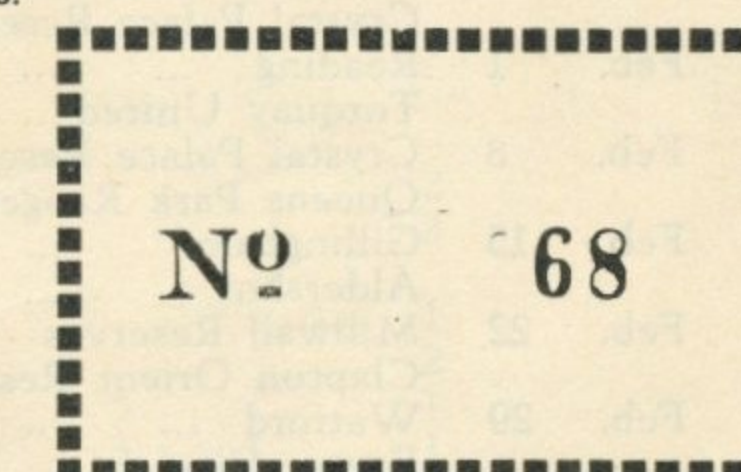
## IMPORTANT

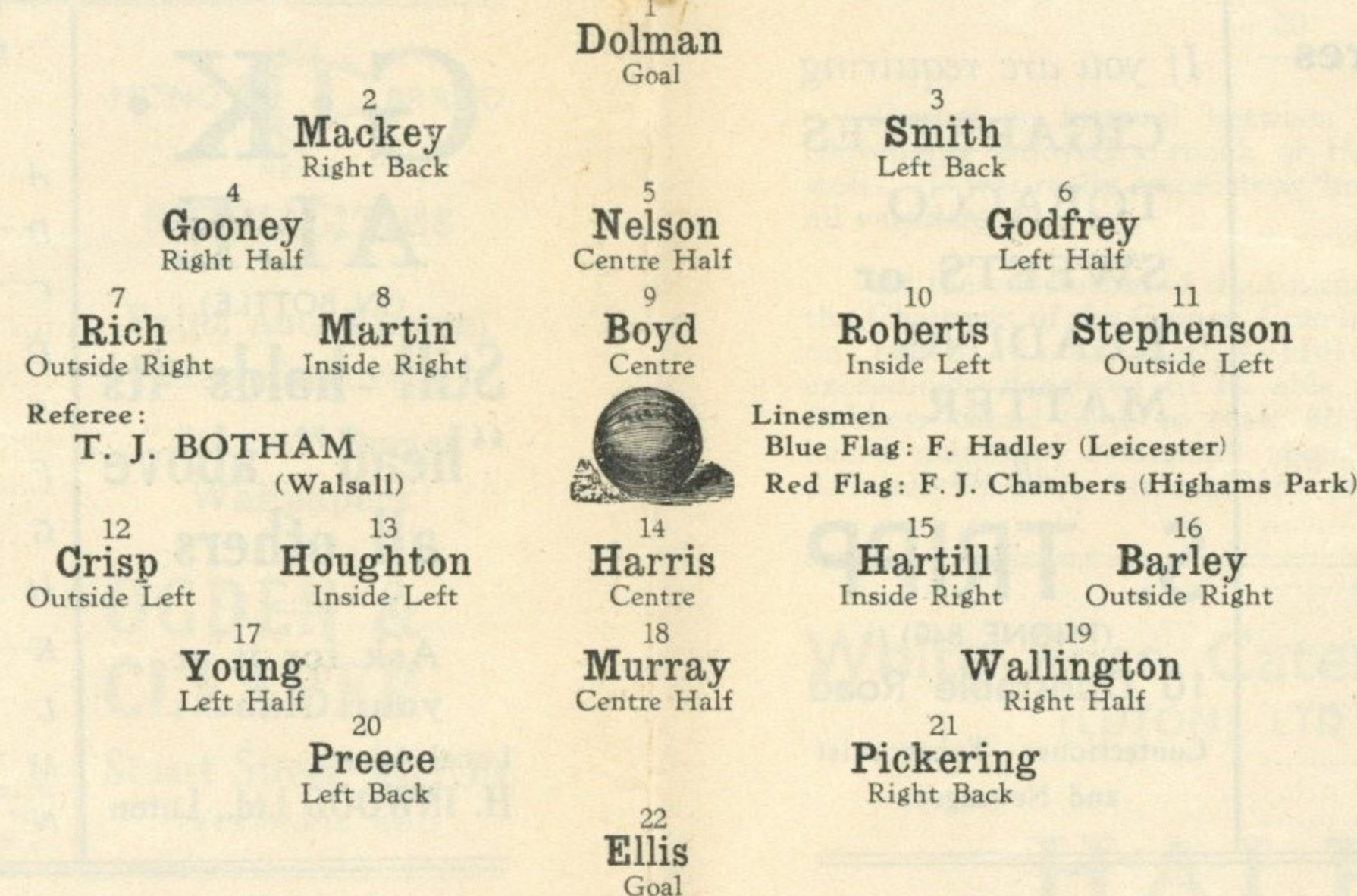
