



FOR the third successive year Southend make Luton their first visit of the season, a habit which has not been unproductive to them since they have taken three points out of the last four. Despite promising beginnings at our expense, however, their playing record during those past two seasons has not caused their supporters unmixed satisfaction.

This season, we learn, there has been a change of policy in which Manager David Jack has played a big part. The playing list has been reduced from 37 professionals last season to only 25 for this campaign. Seven newcomers have been signed and there is one point common to all these seven—they are all big men.

Luton has always been quoted in the seaside town as a team of big fellows and where the skill has been equal Manager Jack has signed the big men—perhaps in the hope of achieving some of the success that has been Luton's of late.

The new men include Jack Everest from Cardiff City. Weighing well over 12 stone, standing 5 ft. 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. he is well up to Southend's new specification. A left back, he was captain of Cardiff last year and is a powerful and determined defender on the field, besides being a humorist in the dressing room. Another new full back is J. Brook from Coventry City, signed at the end of last season. He is 5 ft. 11 ins. and 12 stone. A roving player he has a sure kick in either foot and played some good games for Coventry.

A player considered a real find, however, is Hague, centre half from Derby County, another very well built youngster considered not unlikely to oust Charles Turner from the League side and Turner was capped for the Irish Free State last season. Hague had experience with Derby and has shown his mettle, although unfortunately for Southend, Goddard, regular centre forward, collided with him in last week's practice game and will not be present here today, nor elsewhere for a little while!

Egan is a new inside forward from Brighton. An ash-blond, he was the subject of some big money bidding on the part of Newcastle not long ago. Then he lost form. Southend have signed him and

he appears to have got his confidence back. Dickinson, from Rotherham, where he scored a hatful of goals last season, was previously with Sunderland, is another inside forward who sets a new fashion for Southend with his 5 ft. 10 ins. and 11½ stone measurements. Graham is the new centre forward from Hartlepools, previously with Notts Forest. He is the biggest leader Southend have had, but has been out of training with a pulled muscle. He may be in the side today.

Finally there is Bryan a young goalkeeper from Walsall and Sunderland. In contrast to the other recruits he is only 5 ft. 8 ins. and scales just over 9 stone. Southend, however, have a penchant for small goalkeepers. The regular man, Mackenzie, a youngster from Plymouth is only 5 ft. 7 ins. and less than 10 stone. Was offered cap for Irish Free State last season, and considered Southend's "best ever." It's up to Luton to get past him today.

SEASON TICKETS

The Directors wish to draw the attention of supporters to the Season Tickets that are issued by the Club. These can be obtained in three classes.

First of all is the £3/3/0 ticket which entitles a holder to a seat in the Centre Bay of the Grand

Stand. Here each seat is numbered and a holder makes a choice of a particular seat, which is reserved for him throughout the season. On the occasions of Cup Ties a holder is given first refusal of purchasing the necessary ticket which will enable him to occupy his usual seat.

Secondly there is the £2/4/6 ticket which entitles a holder to either a seat in the Grand Stand (other than the Centre Bay) or alternatively a position in the Enclosure whichever is preferred. On the occasions of Cup Ties a holder of this class of ticket will have first refusal of purchasing a ticket which will enable him to occupy a seat, which will be reserved, in the front rows of the Grand Stand (other than the Centre Bay).

Thirdly there is the Ground Season Ticket, which can be purchased for £1/2/6. As the name implies this ticket enables a holder to obtain admission to the Ground. This innovation begun three years ago and has received increased patronage each season, last season over 530 tickets being sold.

For the benefit of Schoolboys a ticket is issued at £1/2/6 which entitles a holder to a seat in the Grand Stand or a position in the Enclosure.

The Entrances for Season Ticket Holders are as follows:-

1. Main Grand Stand Entrance adjoining Kenilworth Road (for £3/3/- and £2/4/6 holders only)
2. Ivy Road (for Ground Season Ticket Holders only)
3. Maple Road (for all classes of Ticket Holders)


