

ALTHOUGH this is the fourth season since the inception of the Southern Section Cup or to give its full title, "The Football League, Southern Section, Third Division Challenge Cup Competition," the match to be played tonight between Bournemouth and ourselves is the first occasion that a game in this competition has had its venue here. For three consecutive years we have been drawn 'away' but the luck was bound to change.

It would have been impossible to have chosen more attractive opposition than our visitors of this evening, Bournemouth and Boscombe, to pioneer this Cup Competition in Luton, for they are one of the leading clubs of the Southern Section this year occupying the third rung of the League table. Of their eight matches already played they have won five, drawn one and lost two, the results to date being as follows:—

For the game tonight they make only three changes from the team which drew with the "Cobblers" on Saturday last, Gold taking the place of Mellors between the sticks, Marsden occupying Bellis' position at left full back, whilst Kilkar appears in place of Whittam. We, ourselves, make also three changes from the team that beat Reading. Tom Smith's scholastic duties prevent him from playing, so Arthur Hubbard gets a chance for the left back berth. Jock Finlayson and Joe Payne both received knocks on Saturday last—not serious—but

enough to prevent their appearance this evening. However an excellent game should result and may the honour go to the most deserving team.

We, ourselves, have never made much progress in this competition. In the Season 1933-34, the year of its inauguration, we were drawn to play Aldershot on the Wiltshire Club's ground. Although we had practically all of the game we lost by the odd goal in seven. The following season our first venue was Gillingham, where we were successful by three goals to one, but in the next round at Shepherds Bush we were defeated by two goals to one, after having held the Rangers most of the game and also having missed a penalty. Last year we had to visit Swindon, where we were defeated by five goals to three.

We are presenting at each match, to two holders of programmes, a ticket which will enable them to obtain free admission to the Grand Stand at the following match (Cup Ties and Special Matches excepted) that is to be played on this ground.

A board will be taken round the ground during the interval intimating the numbers that have been selected, and holders, who have in their possession programmes bearing these numbers, are requested to make personal application at the office of the Club immediately after the termination of the match, in order to claim these tickets.




