

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

All this **THIS TIME?** can be summed up in a phrase "Promotion this time." But there is a long way to go; fifteen clubs in a bracket of seven points this morning!

Luton are now finding that every game becomes vital, and that opponents produce that "something extra" against them. Bournemouth were not easily beaten last week, and as the **TOWN v. TOWN.** "Seasiders" stand second this morning, they would, no doubt, accord the "Cobblers" a vote of thanks if Luton are checked here to-day. Luton have a hundred per cent. home record, but their six out games have resulted won two, drawn one, lost three. **Mr. A. E. WICKSON**, Luton's Secretary, writes:—

**MR. EDWARD LIDDELL**, Luton Town's New Manager. Born at Whitburn, Co. Durham—famous as a football nursery. Long before the Great War he played for Southampton, Southend United, Clapton Orient and the Arsenal. Experience of Managerial duties with Southend, Queen's Park Rangers, and Fulham, and since has been a main scout for West Ham United. He is confident that Luton have the players capable of winning promotion.

**JOSEPH COEN**, Goalkeeper. Third season. Born at Glasgow. Clydebank, Glasgow Celtic, Guildford City, Bournemouth and Boscombe. Tried by Luton. He made good his position and was first choice custodian until late last season. Timekeeper in a shipyard before coming South.

**DO NOT FORGET ARMISTICE CONCERT,  
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**THOS. S. MACKEY**, Right Back. Fourth season. Born in Durham. Originally a Centre-half. First professional club was Hartlepools United, then three seasons with Sheffield Wednesday. Came to Luton and was developed successfully at Full Back. Can play on either flank. Strong and determined player.

**THOS. S. SMITH**, Left Back. Third season. Born at Higham. Played for Leeds Training College. Turned out for Nelson and Rochdale as a Centre-half during three seasons. At Luton was a success as a flank half and an even greater success at Full Back. School teacher in Luton.

**JOHN FINLAYSON**, Right Half. Second season. Scot. Went to Motherwell as a forward, and later to Cowdenbeath. Left there for Clapton Orient, became a half back. Reverted to half at Luton and became a power as an attacking player.

**JOHN NELSON**, Centre Half. Second season. Born at Chorley. Played for his town club. Transferred to Preston North End, and later to Wolverhampton Wanderers. After three seasons was transferred to Luton 1935-36. Became a grand defensive pivot, and had a great part in the team's success.

**WM. J. FELLOWES**, Left Half. Second season. Born at Bradford, but moved to Tavistock as a youngster. Played for Tavistock Town until Plymouth Argyle made him a professional. Three seasons later to Clapton Orient and was transferred to Luton last season. Was Centre Half but took over the left flank position with success. Has sports outfitting business at Tavistock.

**JOHN T. BALL**, Centre Forward. Third season. Born at Banks, Southport. Played for Southport when in his middle teens, and later for Chorley, Manchester United, Sheffield Wednesday, and Manchester United again. Left for Huddersfield but after a few weeks was transferred to Luton last season but one. Unselfish leader, rare worker, and very clever with his head.

**JOSEPH PAYNE**, Inside Right. Third season. Born at Bolsover. Came to Luton on trial as a Centre Forward three seasons ago. After a term with Biggleswade was brought to Luton and developed as a half-back, where he came on tremendously. Tried in emergency as a Centre Forward. He broke the League goal scoring record by scoring ten of twelve goals against Bristol Rovers. Miner before professional footballer. 17 goals so far.

**FRED ROBERTS**, Inside Left. Third season. Born at Birmingham. From junior football to Smethwick Highfield and thence to Piggott's Works, from which club Birmingham signed him as a professional. After a season was transferred to Luton and has been a regular first team player ever since.

**JOHN HODGE**, Outside Right. Born at Plymouth. Played for St. Austell, Truro City and Green Waves (Plymouth) before being signed as a professional by Plymouth Argyle. After two seasons was transferred to Bristol City in 1934, and passed on to Luton in March last. Is speedy and tricky, and although unfortunate in the matter of injuries should be a great asset to his side this season.

**GEO. STEPHENSON**, Outside Left. Third season. Born in Co. Durham, and played for Durham City. Speedily transferred to Aston Villa. After three was transferred to Luton. Has played many brilliant games since and on his day is almost irresistible. Very tricky and has a good shot. Was a miner.

The "Cobblers" make one change in personnel, and two in position.

**Tolland** moves over to inside left in place of **Riley** (unwell), and **Hewitt** comes in at inside right.

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
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


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**PEN PICTURE**

RALPH ALLEN, the "Cobblers" latest acquisition and centre-forward, was born at Newburn-on-Tyne, Northumberland. His first club was Dipton United in the North Eastern League, from where he was transferred to Fulham, with whom he had 2½ seasons before moving on to Brentford. After 3½ seasons with the "Bees" he was again transferred, this time to Charlton. It was whilst with the latter that he headed the League goal-scorers, and led them during their meteoric rise from the Third Division to the First. His next club was Reading, but he stayed there only six months before he was secured by the "Cobblers." During this present season, prior to coming to the County Ground, he had scored seven goals in ten games for Reading. Stands 5ft. 11½in., and weighs 12 stone. Other favourite game—golf.


