

Then followed a lean time, but in 1888 they were invited to join the English League. The Club was then reconstructed and registered as a Limited Company with the late Mr. A. Williams as Chairman. In 1891 they secured third place in the League and in the same year reached the final of the F.A. Cup. Three years later they went one better and the Cup was brought to Nottingham.

The season 1905 was a bad one, but owing to the League taking in two additional clubs the County retained their status.

One of the most famous players ever associated with the Club was Albert Iremonger, who played in approximately 700 League games during his twenty-two years service.
