





A hearty welcome is extended to our today's visitors from Wales, Cardiff City, and they can be assured of a huge reception from the large number of their co-patriots now resident in Luton.

The City have fallen away somewhat after a very auspicious start, and during the Christmas matches could only garner a solitary point the result of a drawn game with Walsall at Ninian Park. Their two games with Torquay United both went to their opponents. In spite of this however, they have still an interest in the destiny of the League championship, a fact which they have fully emphasised by the recent acquisitions of Meliphany from Plymouth Argyle and MacAulay from Chelsea. The latter is the more well known to us of the two, having been in opposition with the Chelsea team which visited us in the F.A. Cup two years ago. Meliphany has figured in Plymouth Argyle's first team on numerous occasions and will meet old club mates in Rich, Sloan, Gooney and Godfrey, not forgetting to mention also Billy Fellowes.

It was the Welshmen who inflicted upon us our first defeat of the season, and, incidentally up to Saturday last our heaviest, scoring three times without reply, so it is up to our lads today to endeavour to turn the tables. They have no easy task as is only too well known, for Cardiff have a liking for our ground. Last season they earned a draw, sharing four goals.

The results of the Christmas matches were not too good, although is this because we expect too much? The game with Notts County on Xmas Day was a "rouser" and we just about deserved our victory. At Southend on the following day we were much below par, and had to admit defeat by three clear goals, whilst in the return game with

the County on the Monday we were given a taste of the result inflicted on them. The holiday season was not without its quota of injuries and although we have thirty professionals on our staff we were obliged to call upon the services of Arthur Cawdell to complete our Reserve team against the Orient. To add to these misfortunes, although it is hoped to have some of our "injuries" in harness again today, Jack Hodge has been laid low with the 'flu. So it was not a too happy Xmas. Well here's hoping the New Year will be brighter.


