## CLUB GOSSIP

In spite of a troublesome wind, the display given last Saturday was fairly good, and the result, at all events, must have satisfied. There was some misgiving at the interval as to whether the advantage of one goal would be sufficient in view of the strong wind we had to face in the second half, but, in the end, we finished worthy winners by four goals to two.

The Reserves were narrowly beaten by Birmingham, after holding an interval lead, and have again dropped to the foot of the Central League table.

To-day we entertain Luton Town, who were unable to fulfil their fixture with us last Saturday owing to being engaged in a Football Association Cup-tie, in which they suffered the same fate as ourselves by the same score, 3—1, administered by the same opponents, Manchester City.

A question sent us from a supporter who signs himself as "R.C., Walmersley," is of such interest that we hope he will forgive us if we reply to

transferred player gets a percentage of the fee (if so what), and if his old club is bound to pay him anything at all."

The player does not receive any part of the fee, but he may be paid a proportionate sum of money according to the years, one, two, three, four, or five—or per part of per years (as Stanley Holloway would say)—he has put in, in lieu of the benefit he would get if he stayed.

Even that proportion is not fixed, for the amount of a benefit varies. It would surprise most people if they knew how few of even the most powerful and wealthy clubs grant the maximum amount of £650.

It is competent for the selling club to pay the ratio determined by the period of service. But no club is forced to pay anything. It is within its discretion, and subject to the approval of the League authorities.

It is very seldom that permission to pay an accrued share of benefit is withheld, except where there has been cause to believe that the player has "forced" a transfer by measures that are not in accord with the game's

## Club Gossip—Continued.

It is therefore safe to say that almost in every case the transferred man gets the appointed proportion, and that, as often as not, this is an active factor in his giving consent to the move.

But, it should be explained, the player has always a trump card in his hand, for, if he is not satisfied with the arrangements, financial or otherwise, for his transfer he can always decline to be a party to them.

It is still not generally understood that it is his signature which makes the transfer legal. Without it, any deal between two clubs which concerns him is void. The Football League or the Football Association would not recognise it.

To-day one does not hear the old cry of "slavery" which used to be used by people unacquainted with the facts when players were "bought" and "sold." It was assumed that he was a helpless pawn in the game, and that in the bulk of cases he was an unwilling victim.

The fact often is that when a man is not keen to move he is influenced by several considerations—that he handles a useful sum earlier than he would do if he stayed (he cannot otherwise get any portion of his benefit money until he has completed five years' service)—that he may not be getting the chance where he is that he will be afforded where he is going, and that he will be even more popular there with both club and public.

Sometimes people wonder why players fall into line with the wishes of their clubs, for they have a perfect right to look at things from their own point of view.

Generally speaking, it is very seldom that any real obstacle is put in the way of these transactions by the players, who have a keen sense of what they are going to get out of them—and in all these instances, as they are being bartered, they cannot be blamed for a purely personal outlook.

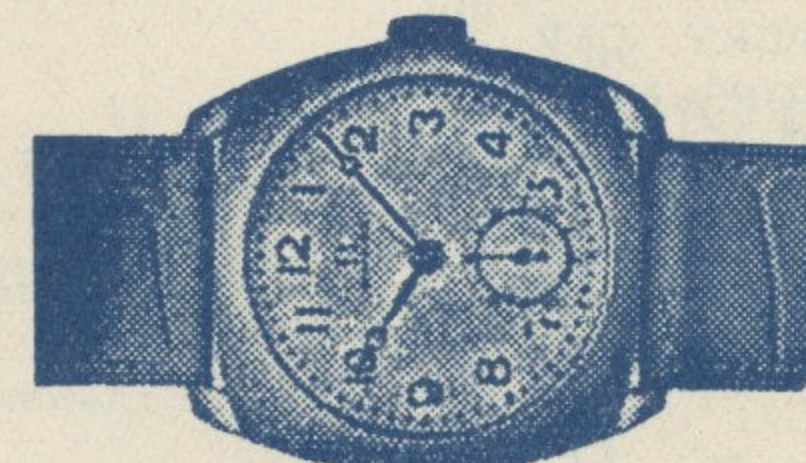

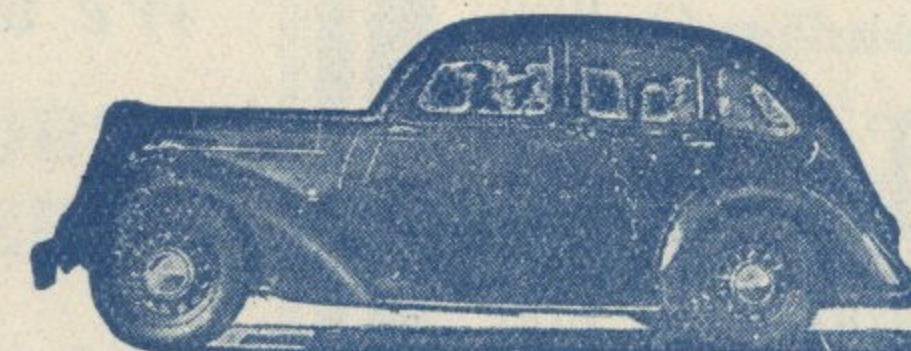
