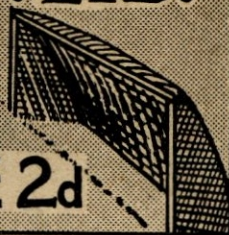

**CLUB NOTES**

To-day we play hosts for the second time this Season to our old friends, Swansea Town. Our first encounter with them was on January 25th last in the Football Association Cup when we beat them by two goals to nil. Swansea have not won their last three away games and as they are fighting hard to avoid relegation to-day's game will be no walk over for our boys. Our opponents are playing in goal, Percy Hooper their latest capture from Tottenham Hotspur, in place of Owen Roberts who played against us earlier in both the League and Cup matches.

The defeat at Tottenham on Saturday last night well be termed a catastrophe. Five minutes before time a defeat was unthinkable—then a free kick taken by Ronnie Dix put paid to our hopes. It was very unfortunate particularly as we had played some grand football and if all the chances had been accepted would have been well in front. At any rate all you stalwarts who saw the game must have been satisfied with our boys' display and if only they could turn their good approach work into goals then promotion would be almost a certainty. Hughie Billington is having some shocking luck this Season for time after time just when in the act of shooting the ball cocks up and by the time it is under control again the chance has gone. But it will not always be so.

You will see by the Combination Cup Table shown at the back of the programme that two points from our hosts at Ipswich this afternoon will take us to quite a respectable position. There are very good prospects here of us winning this section and if our display of last Saturday against Birmingham City can be maintained it is going to take a very good team to beat us.

On Friday next we commence our Easter Holiday fixtures. Our first team have a hard task in front of them, travelling to Manchester next Thursday and immediately after the game on Good Friday to Newcastle, arriving there (according to the time-table) in the early hours of Saturday morning and if our boys are in Luton by 7 on the Sunday evening they will be lucky. There is then another very hard game in front of them on Easter Monday against Manchester City so it will be seen that our lads will not have much rest this Eastertide. We are trying to arrange a Combination Cup game with Northampton Reserves here on Easter Tuesday in order to get all our games played off, but it is not yet certain and more details will be given in our next programme. If it is played it will probably be a 6 o'clock kick-off.

After the game this afternoon with Swansea the Colts will be playing Potton United in a South Midlands fixture. It is a very important game in this League for the winners are almost certain to finish top of the table.

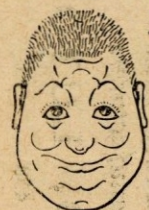
