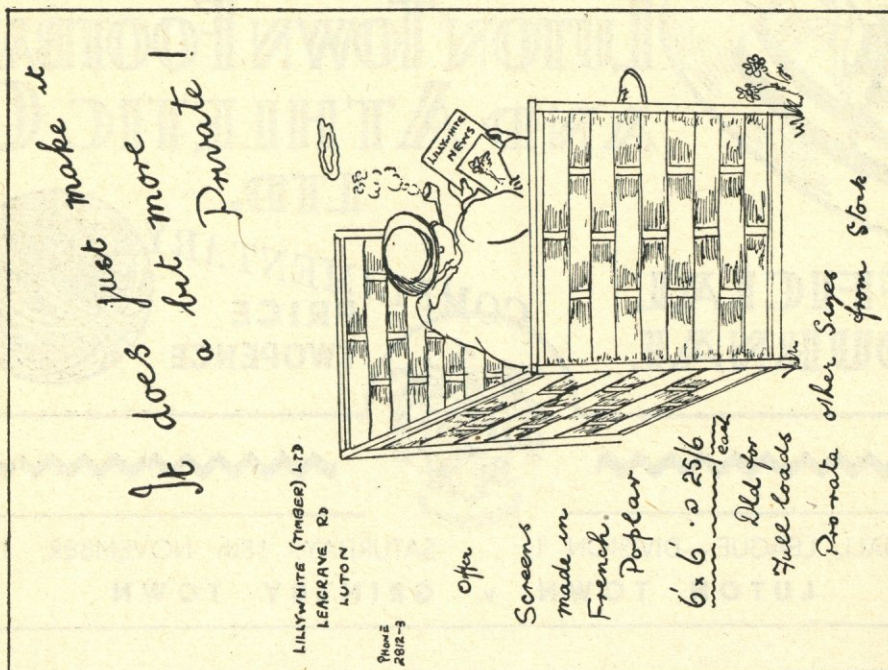

## CLUB NOTES

FIRST of all we want to congratulate the team taking the field for us today on their splendid show last week at Chesterfield. They certainly confounded the critics by the football they played, nothing like it having been seen this season from a Luton side. Everyone was playing for his team and not as an individual, and the enthusiasm and team spirit was a treat to watch. Once more the breaks unfortunately did not come our way otherwise we would have come away from Chesterfield with a very definite away from home win to show in the records. The defence played superbly, with Bernard Streten playing with all his old confidence. This was expected of them and they did not disappoint us, but the forwards played better than we had dared hope, playing the ball confidently, slipping it to the man who had moved into the open space, running into position to receive the return pass and all the time the ball on the move towards the opponent's goal. Ray Middleton unfortunately for us had one of his "on" days and only once were we able to beat him by a lovely effort from Bobby Wyldes who, incidentally had his best game for Luton so far and gave International right back Milburn an awful dance. As trainer Ralph Hann said after the match "If only the lads would play like this at Kenilworth Road we would have near ground capacity every match." We sincerely hope they will give us a repeat in today's match, we know the lads themselves will be very disappointed if they don't.

We would ask you, however, to encourage them in their efforts. Encouragement undoubtedly goes a long way in helping a player to have a good game, so cheer them on, let us hear again the "Kenilworth Roar" and the results will come.

We were informed during the week that Bud Aherne has again been chosen to represent his country in an International Match. This time it is to play against Norway and we are very happy to release him in order to play. It means however he will not be playing for us at Birmingham next Saturday, but fortunately we have a capable deputy in Les. Lake who will not let the side down. We sincerely trust Bud has a good game and that further honours will come his way.

Talking of honours reminds us that Iorwerth Hughes played a very good game for his country at Sunderland last Wednesday. Although beaten four times he could not be blamed for any goal and from remarks heard after the match he is due for further honours if he continues to play so well.

Which brings us to a very sticky point that has been at the back of the Manager's mind these last few days. Bernard Streten as already stated, had a good match last Saturday. Iorwerth Hughes had a good match playing for his country only last

Wednesday. Which one is to play in the first team here today? Is it fair on Bernard to drop him, is it fair on Iorwerth to drop him on his consistently good games since he wore the senior jersey and particularly after his splendid game at Sunderland? The Manager in the end has decided on Iorwerth Hughes. Some of you will agree with this and some not, but although very disappointed Bernard has taken the decision in his usual sporting manner and was the first to congratulate Iorwerth on seeing the team sheet. This of course is the stuff of which men are made.

While on the subject of goalkeepers we have been fortunate in obtaining the services of Eric Stibbards as a full time professional in this capacity. He has been showing very good work while playing in the Mid-Week League for us as an Amateur, and we are quite sure that with proper training he will make a first-class custodian. We have been more or less forced into this position as Derek Williams is in the Forces and likely to be for at least another eighteen months. As he is stationed in the North of England and it is mostly inconvenient for him to get week-end leave in order to play for us, we would have been in a sticky position if either Hughes or Streten was not able to play and Williams unable to obtain leave, and so we asked Stibbards to sign on the dotted line. We have not forgotten young Douglas Johnston who has been keeping goal for us in the Metropolitan League side and doing it very well too. He is improving each match and his opportunity will come in time.

Fresh from their triumph last Saturday, when they beat Brentford by seven goals to two, the "Fishermen" come here today no doubt confident they will repeat the whacking they meted out to us on their last visit here, which was in the Third Round of the F.A. Cup. The previous week at Grimsby they had beaten us by the devastating score of six goals to one, and who shall query their confidence in repeating the medicine, particularly considering our present position in the League. We, however, have other ideas, and so we shall see a very interesting game here today.

The Luton Schoolboys will be playing here again next Saturday, when they will entertain Northampton Schoolboys in the Third Round of the English Schools' Trophy Competition. So far the Luton Boys have scored 15 goals without reply in the two matches so far played in this Competition, and as these Boys are playing at present it will take a very good team indeed to prevent them making further headway. It was a most enjoyable match here last Saturday morning when Kettering Boys were beaten by five clear goals and no doubt another match as entertaining will be played here next Saturday. Come along those of you who can and you will not be disappointed. Kick-off is at 11 o'clock.

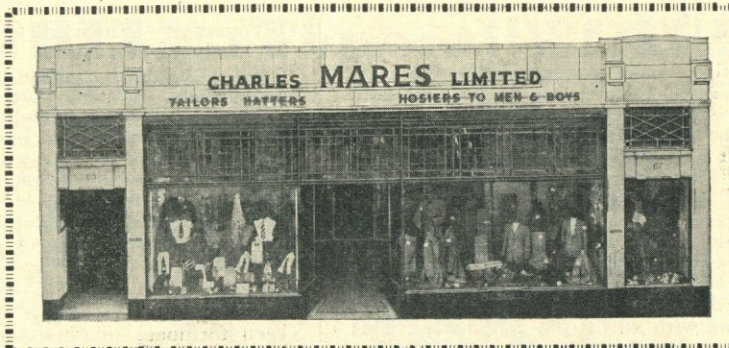

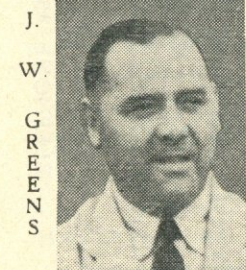
