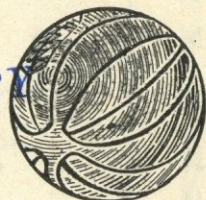
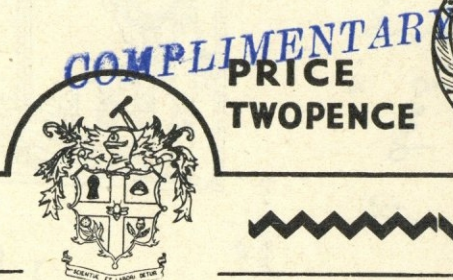

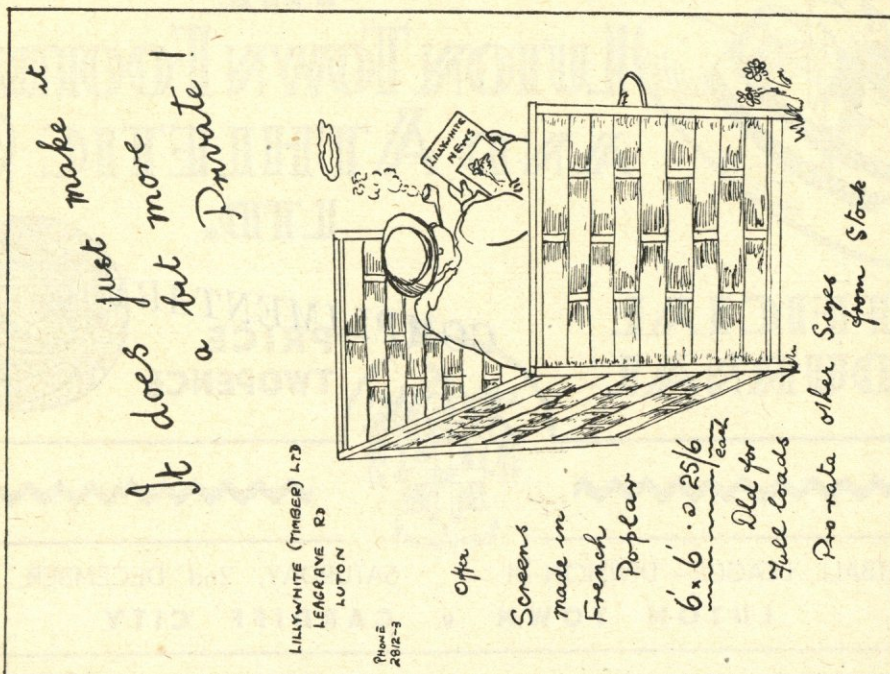

## CLUB NOTES

IT is with pleasure that we welcome another visit by the Cardiff City team to Kenilworth Road today. They are playing very well just at present, last Saturday obtaining their fifth home win of the season at the expense of Sheffield United by two clear goals. To date they have not lost a game at Ninian Park, having drawn their other four home games, scoring fifteen goals against eight. Their away record however is not much better than ours, which gives us the hope that our home record will be improved by today's game. Cardiff have played nine away matches, five having been drawn and four lost, goals scored five against ten. They have had only eighteen goals scored against them in their eighteen games played so far, easily the best defensive record in the Division, but they have found the net on only twenty occasions, only one more than ourselves. On the face of it therefore everything points to a very hard game with very few goals into the bargain, but in this game nothing is certain and we may see more goals scored in this match than any other this season. But however many are scored we are hoping of course that we score more than the other side. As an indication of Cardiff's strong defence, in their last three away games, at Doncaster, Swansea and Barnsley, they have conceded only one goal, at Vetch Field, although they had not been able to find the net themselves.

We had to admit defeat at St. Andrew's Ground, last Saturday, after a gruelling game, when we suffered more injuries than any other game for a long time and certainly this season. In the first few minutes Iorworth Hughes required the attention of Ralph Hann for a nasty knock on his thigh which undoubtedly affected his mobility. Les. Lake and Charlie Watkins also suffered from nasty knocks for the best part of the game and then Bobby Wyldes received a most severe kick about ten minutes from the end which has put him out of the game for at least six weeks. He is suffering from a small bone broken in an ankle and has had his leg placed in a plaster cast. This is most unfortunate as Bobby was playing very well just now and to fill his place will require some switching about as at the moment he is the only recognised outside left we have on the books. Billy Havenga has been chosen to play in this position this afternoon which is a great pity as he was settling down very nicely in the senior

side on the other flank. Bud Aherne, after his very good game in Dublin last Sunday against Norway, resumes at left back and although Les. Lake played quite well we feel that the return of Bud will strengthen our defences. Billy Arnison had his further operation last Tuesday, and according to reports received is progressing very well. The Surgeon who carried out the operation is very confident that he found the cause of the pain and that Billy will be playing again in a few weeks time. We sincerely hope he is right for a player of this calibre is too good to be watching matches from the touchline each week, and especially considering our present position in the League.

It is with much regret that we record the passing of Mr. Harry Smart, one of our oldest and staunchest Members. He had been associated with this Club in one capacity or another practically from its inception, having served as Secretary, Director and Life Member in turn. Every Saturday he was to be seen in his place in the Directors' Box, no matter what the weather, and the Board Room will not seem to be complete without him this afternoon. Another old Member who has served the Club well and who is finding life rather hard at the moment is Mr. Charlie Green, another stalwart who has been Secretary and is at present a Life Member. He is in the St. Mary's Hospital and we know he would welcome a visit or a letter from any one of you who knew him when he took an active part in the Club's affairs. Certainly Luton Town Football Club is all the better off for having enjoyed the services of these two gentlemen.

As our First Eleven will be playing away these next two Saturdays, the Draw for the Third Round of the F.A. Cup will take place before another issue of our Official Programme. Those of you wishing to apply for Tickets will you please wait until you see the announcement in the Press before doing so, when full particulars will be given. Any applications received before then will not take precedence over those from people carrying out this request.

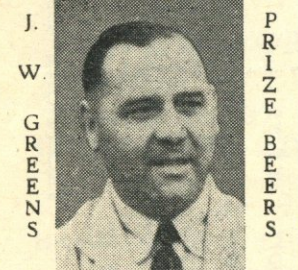
