From the Board Room.

TODAY'S match with Luton Town is the last of our Easter Holiday games, and in common with other professional footballers, our players will be pleased to be able to leave football alone for a day or two. Three matches in four days is a lot to ask of players in the hard and strenuous league football of today, and both teams will be feeling the effects of their busy Easter programmes. We do not know the results of these previous matches at the time of writing, as these programmes have to be prepared before the printers close down for the Easter Holidays. We hope of course that the outcome of our own games has been favourable, and that our league position is more secure than when these notes were written. If we have failed to achieve this, then the two games still to be played will be terrific battles, as Sheffield Wednesday, who we play at home next Saturday, and Leeds United away the following week, both have promotion chances.

On page 5 we give the latest Football Combination league tables, Sections A & B. Although they are not quite complete, the remaining games cannot materially alter the positions. As mentioned earlier in these notes, the sections will in future be discontinued, and replaced by Divisions I & II, with promotion and relegation, involving four clubs in each league. The two leagues will be determined by the positions shown, the top eight in each section forming Division I, and the remainder comprising Division II. The change makes the league more competitive, and therefore, it should be more attractive.

LUTON TOWN visit us today, and we welcome these old rivals to Coventry. Whatever happened yesterday, we can expect a keen and hard-fought game against these opponents of third division days. Our visitors have had a fairly good season, and in the early part kept for a long period well amongst the leaders. They are a team to be reckoned with away from home, as at time of writing, they have obtained 17 points from 18 games. We won today's corresponding game last season by four goals to one.

We are asked by the Football Association to point out that Cup Final tickets issued to supporters must under no circumstances be resold. If the recipients are unable to use them personally, they must be returned to us in time for distribution to other supporters.

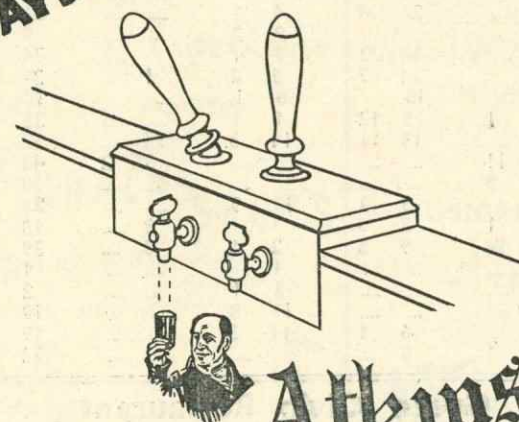


