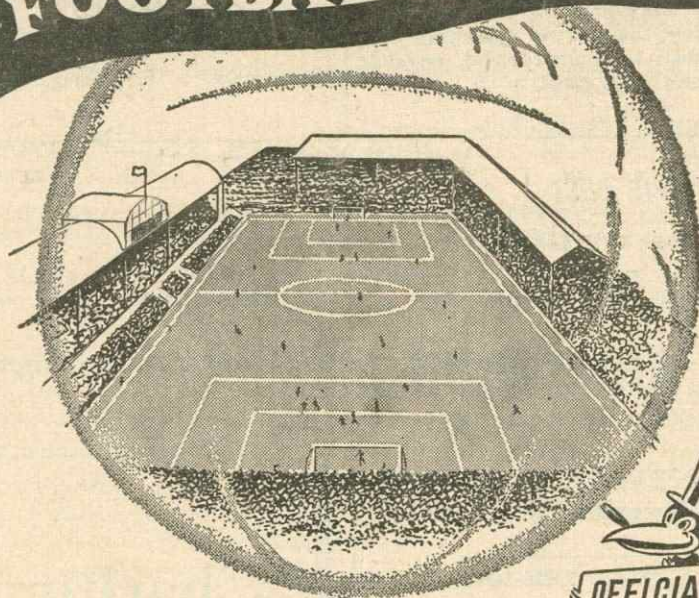

Newcastle United are today sharing with Sheffield Wednesday relegation positions in the League. It is sad to see the team in such a position but they are still favourites, among the several clubs in danger of going down, to make a safety rise in the table.

The "Magpies" have two games in hand of Leicester City, Sunderland, and Sheffield Wednesday.

They also boast a better goal average to date.

But to rely on these undoubted advantages for safety would be foolish.

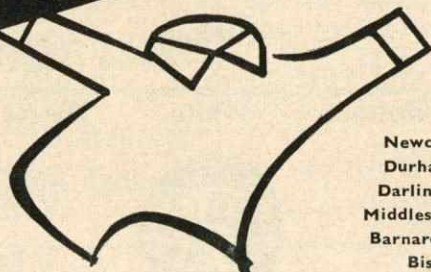

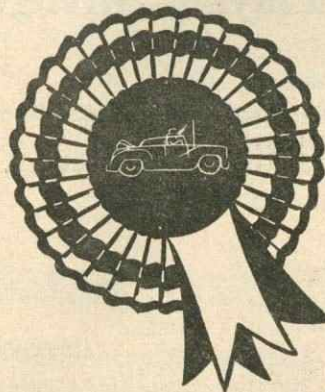

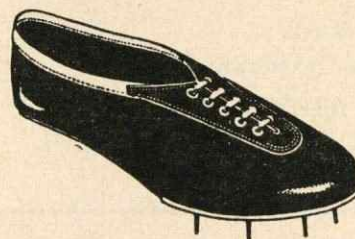
