**Club Notes**

WE went to Newcastle last Saturday in the hope that we would be able to bring away at least a point in view of the Geordies' disappointing form to date. If Alwyn McGuffie, who had been brought in at the last minute due to Tommy McKechnie failing in a fitness test, had not slipped at the crucial moment of connecting after some very nice approach work into the Newcastle penalty box we would have taken an early lead and no doubt gone on to victory. But just as he was hitting the ball his left foot slipped on the greasy turf and the ball went straight to the goalkeeper. A few minutes later a goal was scored against us right out of the blue when the ball, which should have been cleared, went to Len Allchurch who was as surprised as anybody to receive it, but who hit it on the offchance and it wizzed into the net giving Ron Bayham no chance whatsoever. The ball could have gone anywhere. This goal gave the Newcastle side all the confidence that had been lacking, and in the end we suffered rather a heavy defeat. It was again a case of that all-important first goal. We have not done badly this season however, for this was our first defeat away from home since we played at Swansea at the beginning of September, and with our lads playing so well we had hoped to continue the good work, but it was not to be.

Tonight we receive Rotherham United in the Second Round of the Football League Cup and welcome them once again to Kenilworth Road. They were last Season's Finalists in this Competition, losing to Aston Villa in the Final on aggregate by 3 goals to 2. Last season five Clubs did not enter the Competition, these being Arsenal, Sheffield Wednesday, Tottenham Hotspur, West Bromwich Albion and Wolverhampton. This season in addition to these same five Clubs five more have decided not to enter, these being Burnley, Chelsea, Everton, Manchester United and Liverpool. This leaves 82 Clubs who have entered, which is a very awkward number to cater for in arranging the various Rounds. The League have decided to arrange the Competition as follows to have four Clubs for the Semi - Finals :—

1st Round  
82 Clubs = 40 matches and 2 byes

2nd Round  
42 Clubs = 21 matches

3rd Round  
21 Clubs = 10 matches and 1 bye

4th Round  
11 Clubs = 3 matches and 5 byes

5th Round  
8 Clubs = 4 matches

with the proviso that no Club shall have a bye in successive Rounds. We give this information as several people have enquired how the Rounds are to be arranged as there are more than 64 Clubs involved. We hope to see an entertaining game this evening against this team of youngsters who are certainly setting the pace in the League at the moment.

The Show Biz side is not yet agreed upon as there are so many contingencies to contend with but we are assured by the Show Biz Organisers of a very good turn-out. Tickets at 2/6 to the Terrace, Bobbers Stand and Enclosure, and 5/- Stand (Unreserved Seats) may be obtained at the Office or the Electrolux Recreation Club together with Souvenir Programmes at 1/- each. The Charities to benefit are — Luton and District Spastics, Old People's Social Centre, and The Bedfordshire Association for the Advancement of Children with Defective Hearing. Good causes all and well worth supporting.

## PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

**Gordon Morriss** (goalkeeper). 6 ft. 2 ins. Gordon was first spotted playing in Junior Football and was signed on Amateur Forms in May 1960, and as a deputy was needed to Roy Ironside for the tour of Finland in May of this year, Gordon was asked if he would like to join the party. This he readily did and joined the full-time playing staff in June.

**Peter Perry** (full back). 5 ft. 9 ins. Peter came to Rotherham as an amateur in Season 1953/54, and for two seasons played in our Northern Intermediate League side. Signed as a part-time professional in July 1956.

**Lol Morgan** (full back). 5 ft. 9 ins. Lol joined Rotherham after having spent several years with Huddersfield Town, whom he joined as a boy on their ground staff. Signed a G.2 form in August 1954 and it wasn't long before he gained a regular place in the left back position.

**Roy Lambert** (half back). 5 ft. 10 ins. Roy is a product of Sheffield Junior Football and came to Rotherham from Thorncliffe Welfare, who were then members of the Sheffield Association League. In May 1954 he was signed as a full-time professional.

**Peter Madden** (centre half). 6 ft. 2 ins. Peter was a product of Junior Football in Bradford and joined Rotherham from Thornton Juniors on a part-time basis in October 1955. After a season in the then Midland League, he was signed on a full-time basis in 1956.

**Ray Lancaster** (half back). 6 ft. Ray was recommended to us in the 1957/58 Season and he was signed on amateur forms in April 1958. He was introduced

into our Northern Intermediate League side at the beginning of the 1958/59 Season, and after two months was promptly introduced on to our full-time playing staff.

**Barry Webster** (outside right). 5 ft. 8 ins. Barry, a native of Sheffield, was first spotted playing with Gainsboro' Trinity in the Midland League by our then Chief Scout Joe McGuire, and was signed as a professional in May 1956. For two years was the Club's top goal scorer.

**Alan Kirkman** (inside forward). 5 ft. 10 ins. Alan was transferred from Manchester City in February 1959 to help the scoring potential of the first team, and this he has done admirably. Since then he has occupied most of the forward positions. It is true to say, but for having been dogged with bad luck, he would have been the Club's top goal scorer last Season.

**Don Weston** (inside forward). 5 ft. 8 ins. Don was bought from Birmingham City in December 1960 for a fee of £10,000 as a centre forward, who some six months earlier had bought him from Wrexham for a fee estimated to be in the region of £15,000. Most of the time he has played in either of the inside positions and has featured regularly on the score sheet.

**Kenneth Waterhouse** (inside forward). 5 ft. 10 ins. Kenneth, a native of Ormskirk in Lancashire was transferred from Preston in May 1958, having spent the previous twelve years with them as a centre forward. For a while he played in that capacity at Millmoor, but it was realised that the half back position was more his vocation.




