



CLUB NOTES

Luton Town are comparative strangers to the Deepdale scene with only seven previous league engagements on this ground, despite the fact that the present season is their 38th as members of the Football League competition, and the 35th without a break. Actually our association with them goes back to February 2nd, 1895, when we visited Luton in the First Round of the F.A. Cup tournament.

Luton's first excursion to Deepdale was as recently as January, 1950, in the Second Division, when they defeated us by a lone goal, during a disastrous North End slump of six games without a win, including the Watford Cup replay debacle.

Paradoxically the "Hatters" ancestry harks back some 76 years, the Club being founded in 1885 from the remains of two local soccer organisations known as Excelsior F.C., and Wanderers F.C. Of mutual interest concerning the bygone days is the matter of professional status being forced upon the then reluctant supreme ruling body. In 1891 Luton pioneered this movement in the South, several years after North End had played a similarly successful role in the North. They gained admission to the Football League (Division Two) in 1897, but after two seasons they were not re-elected and so returned to the Southern League. When League Three South was created for season 1920-21 they became one of the elected 22 clubs.

Champions in season 1936-37 with further promotion in 1955 when the Bedfordshire team sampled top class football for the first time. They were relegated at the end of the 1959-60 season to coincide with Tom Finney's last League game on the final day. The Luton record on this ground is won one, drawn one and lost five.



MEET THE OPPOSITION

- R. BAYNHAM** (*Goalkeeper*). Has been with Luton Town since 1951. Secured from Southern League Club, Worcester City. Has represented England on several occasions. Played for the Football League versus the League of Ireland on two occasions and also for the England 'B' Team versus the Yugoslavia 'B.' Was a member of the F.A. Touring Party to South America.
- B. McNALLY** (*Full Back*). Can occupy either full back position. Came from the League of Ireland Club, Shelbourne and has been with Luton since May, 1956. Played for Eire 'B' versus Rumania in Dublin in 1957 and also for Eire versus Czechoslovakia.
- J. BRAMWELL** (*Full Back*). One of the two players who joined Luton from Everton when Billy Bingham, the Irish International, was transferred to that Club during the middle of last October. Is a very capable player and we are very surprised he has not been considered for International honours.
- R. MORTON** (*Wing Half or Centre Forward*). Local born and has been with the Club since 1948. Played for England 'B' versus Switzerland 'B' team, the Football Combination versus the Dutch XI (on two occasions) and also for the Football Association versus the Army. Was chosen as a reserve for England at Wembley in 1955 and again when they played Ireland in 1958.
- R. COPE** (*Centre Half*). Signed from Manchester United just before the opening of the season. Has spent all his footballing career with Manchester United, signing as an Amateur with them in 1950, turning professional in 1951. Was an England Schoolboy International. Has made 150 appearances for Manchester United in the First Team.
- J. GROVES** (*Wing Half or Inside Forward*). Won Derbyshire Schoolboy honours and was signed by Luton when only 15. Uses his height to great advantage and is a most accurate distributor of the ball.

- H. WALDEN** (*Outside Right*). Joined Luton from Kettering last January and stepped straight into the first team at Norwich. An elbow injury prevented him from playing in the final weeks of last season, but he is now fully fit.
- G. TURNER** (*Centre or Inside Forward*). Came to Luton as a wing half upon his demob. from the Navy but found his true position in the forward line. Represented the English League versus the Scottish League in 1955 and also played for the F.A. XI versus the Army in 1958.
- J. LORNIE** (*Centre Forward*). An Aberdonian, he arrived here from Leicester City whom he joined in 1958 as an Inside Forward. Was converted to Centre Forward in which position he played several times in the City First Team.
- A. ASHWORTH** (*Inside Forward*). The player, who with Bramwell, joined Luton when Bingham was transferred to Everton. A very progressive player always looking for the ball.
- J. FLEMING** (*Outside Left*). Came to Luton from Patrick Thistle when they transferred Joe McBride, in November, 1960. Is a very capable player with a tremendous shot and good turn of speed.
- T. KELLY** (*Centre Half*). Born in Luton. Played for Hitchin Town before joining the Town in 1950. Originally played wing half but was successfully converted into a Centre Half. A very strong player who holds his own with most centre forwards.
- A. McGUFFIE** (*Wing Half or Inside Forward*). Signed professional forms for Luton in September, 1954. Has made numerous appearances in the First Team since his demob from the Army. Is an excellent distributor of the ball with a flare for coming through to have a shot at goal.
- D. PACEY** (*Wing Half*). First signed for the Club in 1956. Since his demob. from the Army he has played for the F.A. versus the R.A.F. and was also a member of the England Under-23 team against Germany and Italy.


