

Club Comments and Views

OWING to the holidays these notes have been written before the result of the match with Derby County is known and this gives me the chance to deal with the achievements of our Reserve team.

Their battle for the championship of the Midland Intermediate League has been suspended along with all others, while the cup competition is played off.

Before the suspension of the race Walsall were heading the table just a nose in front of Aston Villa "A" and had been defeated only once.

Their conquerors on this occasion were West Bromwich Albion "A" but Walsall extracted full revenge last

Saturday when they made the trip to West Bromwich again.

This time there was no mistake with Walsall hitting five goals without reply. This was the same number of goals as they hit the previous week when beating Aston Villa "A" at Fellows Park.

The visitors did score two goals on this occasion but it did nothing to dislodge Walsall from the top of their section of this cup competition. They have yet to drop a point and look like being in the Final.

Three of the players, Tony Eden, Trevor Foster and Norman Rowe have been ever-presents in this team and Norman is the leading goalscorer in cup and league combined with 19 goals. Several of the others have only missed the odd game or so, these being Frank Gregg, Alan Roper and Tim Rawlings.

The "A" team have also been doing well in the Staffs. County League and recently topped the table for the first time since they became members of the league, although they have recently fallen from grace a bit. Several of the teams below them have games in hand so they may lose their exalted position in the next few weeks.

Goalkeeper :

R. BAYNHAM. Has been with Luton Town since 1951. Has represented England on several occasions. Played for the Football League versus the League of Ireland.

Full-backs :

B. McNALLY. Came from the League of Ireland Club, Shelbourne, and has been with Luton since May, 1956.

J. BRAMWELL. One of two players who joined Luton from Everton in place of Billy Bingham, the Irish International.

Half-backs :

D. PACEY. First signed for the Club in 1956. Since his demob. from the Army he has played for the F.A. versus the R.A.F.

R. COPE. Signed from Manchester United just before the opening of the season. Has spent all his footballing career with Manchester United.

J. GROVES. Won Derbyshire Schoolboy honours and was signed by Luton when only 15. Uses his height to great advantage and is a most accurate distributor of the ball.

Forwards :

H. WALDEN. Joined Luton from Kettering last January and stepped straight into the first team at Norwich. An elbow injury prevented him from playing in the final weeks of last season, but he is now fully fit.

T. McKECHNIE. Born Glasgow and came here direct from Rob Roy at the end of last season. Has shown excellent promise in the trial games and is undoubtedly a player of the future.

A. ASHWORTH. The player who, with Bramwell, joined Luton when Bingham was transferred to Everton. A very progressive player always looking for the ball.

A. McGUFFIE. Signed professional forms for Luton in September, 1954. Has made numerous appearances in the First Teams since his demob. from the Army.

J. FLEMING. Came to Luton from Partick Thistle when we transferred Joe McBride, in November, 1960. Is a very capable player with a tremendous shot and good turn of speed.
