FOLLOWING our very disappointing display against relegation -haunted Bury last Saturday we receive at Kenilworth Road another team not too happy about their position in the League and in fact a defeat to-day for them could bracket them with those teams occupying bottom places. Last Saturday the Brighton lads did well to play a goalless draw at home to Southampton, as they had done at Sunderland the previous Saturday, and with the acquisition during this week of Johnny Caven from Airdrieonians to help boost the attack they will be hoping to at least enjoy a draw here to-day. Although placed so low in the Table Brighton have won their matches at Bristol Rovers, Charlton and Stoke—while draws at Leeds, Scunthorpe, Walsall and Sunderland have helped them to augment their poor home record of four wins and six draws in the fifteen matches played at the Goldstone Ground. When we played at Brighton last October we lost by the odd goal in three. We felt we should have won that match for we had led until 18 minutes from the end but then Johnny Goodchild scored which set the Brighton lads alight and it came as no surprise when with only ten minutes to go Bobby Laverick hooked the ball past Jim Standen to give them the lead and the victory. If however our forwards earlier in the game had taken their chances a different story would have been told. We must see to it that they do not register their second "double" of the season to-day (their first was obtained at the expense of Stoke City).


