

Editor's Notes

The pre-match setting of a Millmoor game can hardly have been gloomier than that this afternoon when we welcome Luton Town. In fact there is no escaping the fact that the popular habit during the week is to have a shade of odds on how many there will be below the previous home attendance . . . such is the price of extended failure.

But, very conscious of the vagaries of football, would it be very wrong to start sounding a cheerful and local note . . . Many are shaking their heads and saying: It's the end of football at Millmoor.

Never has there been more abundant evidence of my permanent contention that to the average supporter you are as good as your previous result. The pro's and con's of the United failure, heightened of course because so much was at stake when the slide started, are far too numerous to start upon here.

In any case, as it is the privilege of the chap who pays his cash, the rank and file club loyalist, has his own view what has gone wrong. No amount of official comment of club theory will change or bend his point of view.

Good luck to him. The right of the bloke on the terrace to say and think what he likes about the game is a cherished feature of the greatest game on earth.

READERS' QUERIES ANSWERED

Argus (Monkwood) asks: Could you please inform us when B. Moore was transferred from Rotherham, and to which club. Was it Scarborough?

Bobbit Moore was sold to Chesterfield on 24th October, 1956 after having played three first team games that season.

It seems odd to record that we are meeting Luton this afternoon for the fourth time this term. We played them in a very exciting game at Kenilworth Road in December (losing 4-3), having drawn there in the League cup in October and winning the replay at Millmoor 2-0.

Brian Taylor scored one of the Rotherham goals in the League match game in which he touched the direct and effective sort of action that originally made him an attraction to United.

A flourishing finish to the season, in this sort of vein, would be most welcome. In the League game with the 'Hatters' Ray Lancaster had just commenced a spell of regular first team appearances. He returned to the side at Southampton last Saturday with some credit in a team performance which was not at all bad according to the consensus of reports.

What escaped the majority of attention was that half the team were playing with a certain amount of discomfort from vaccination reaction. These 'jabs' had been considered necessary after the visit of Swansea. The Town team had included Mel Nurse who a few days earlier had been a visitor to the tragic Bridgend area hospital from which at the time of writing there had been no fewer than eleven deaths reported.






