

### **Club Notes**

AT the time these notes were being prepared — last Wednesday afternoon — the rain was falling fast and the prospect for a nice Easter looked very bleak indeed. We hope however the Weather Clerk relented in time for everybody to enjoy nice sunshine for the holiday.

With such a long time elapsing between the preparation of the notes and to-day's match much could have happened to the several Clubs in all Divisions interested in Promotion and Relegation, and none so much as it affects our opponents of to-day. Last Wednesday they were lying second in the Table with a two-point lead over Sunderland in third place. Since then they will already have played us at Brisbane Road on Good Friday and have made the journey to Norwich on Saturday. Sunderland have meanwhile played only once, at home to Newcastle United on Saturday, are at home to Rotherham United this afternoon and play their third Easter match at Rotherham to-morrow. It is unlikely therefore that in this morning's papers Leyton Orient have been disposed of their position as second to Liverpool but nevertheless the matches played could have a big bearing on the ultimate final placings next Saturday. Then Leyton Orient are at home to Bury whereas Sunderland have the long journey to Swansea. It is an intriguing position for both Clubs for neither can allow any slip-up.

Leyton Orient, formerly Clapton Orient until Season 1946/47, was Founded in 1881 and were elected to the League Division II in 1905. They continued in this Division until they were relegated at the end of season 1928/29, remaining in the Third Division (South) until their promotion season 1955/56 and have been in the Second Division since then. Last season they finished in fourth position from the bottom, the four points they obtained from us proving very useful in keeping them clear of relegation. During the Close Season they made a very astute move in appointing Mr. Jack Carey their Manager when they found that Everton no longer required his services. The signing of Dave Dunmore from West Ham United on the last day of signing last season and the experience of Jack Carey in the Managerial Chair provided just that push forward this team required, with the result that throughout the present season they have been breathing down the neck of Liverpool in first place. It is unlikely that Leyton Orient will finish as Champions, but they will be quite satisfied to finish in second place and so become members of the First Division for the first time in their long history.

Mention of long history reminds us that Notts. County Football Club was formed in 1862, and they are thus in their Centenary Year. They are arranging a Centenary Match at Meadow Lane, on Wednesday, 2nd May, kick-off 6.30 p.m. Notts. County versus An England Eleven. We wish the occasion every success.

We congratulate the Luton Band on their magnificent performance in the London and Southern Counties' Area Championship last Saturday to be adjudicated Second place and thus qualify to play in the Finals at the Royal Albert Hall next October. They are incidentally joining forces with the Luton Amateur Operatic Society for the evening of Sunday, May 13th to give a Concert in the Assembly Hall of the Luton College of Technology, commencing at 7.30 p.m. It will undoubtedly prove to be one of the highlights of the musical season in Luton.

The Secretary of the Bradwell Silver Band has written expressing their great

joy on playing once more at Kenilworth Road. The Collection amounted to £8 7s. 6d. of which £6 will have to be paid for their transport, but they had a wonderful reception for which they say in return 'Thank you all very much.' We feel very fortunate in being able to call on both the Bradwell and Heath & Reach Silver Bands when the Luton Band is not able to perform here.

Next Saturday, for our last match of the season we have been fortunate in getting the Butlin Young Ladies to give a Pre-match Display. They will begin about 2.30 p.m. so hope quite a few of you will be here in time to see this very fine exhibition of Movement in Rhythm.
