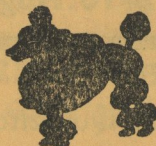

CLUB NOTES

OUR VISITORS. This evening we extend a warm welcome to Luton Town on their first visit to Haig Avenue. They have come to town following Saturday's home draw with Leeds United in this the second round of the Football League Cup. Luton have several links with Southport. Trainer Frank King used to be a local policeman and fireman after serving Everton and Derby County as a goalkeeper. He played with us during the war until giving up through injury. Our former manager Wally Fielding left us to join Luton as assistant trainer and coach, but is no longer with the Hatters, who also had on their books, local schoolboy product Alec Ashworth, ex-Everton, like Fielding. Ashworth was transferred to Northampton just before the present season started. The Town, like ourselves, have not started at all well and they have only one away point to date. They have just paid a big fee to Arsenal for right winger Danny Clapton to add strength to their attack, and in Saturday's game they rallied well after being two down. In defence former England goalkeeper, Ron Baynham, has recently been replaced by Jim Standen, ex-Arsenal. Lining up are Eire international full back Brendan McNally and former Everton player, while Cup Final leader Bob Morton is at wing half. Left half Dave Pacey also played for Luton in the 1959 Cup Final. Leader Gordon Turner scored 20 goals last season. It promises to be an entertaining cup tie and if our boys can reproduce the form shown at Rochdale last week they must have a chance. But they will have to do far better than at Tranmere on Friday when the defence crumbled in the second half. It was a night to forget so far as we are concerned, but it did emphasise the need to strengthen the staff as quickly as possible.

FRIDAY'S GAME. We have another home fixture on Friday when Torquay United will be here. Many people are asking "Why Friday?" The reason is, as previously announced, that the game has been brought forward from Saturday to avoid clashing with Everton's home game. This was the one occasion in the season when a home match of ours clashed with Everton's. This time Torquay come to town as one of the leading sides in the Fourth Division and, as such, we are hoping they will be quite a draw. Their record shows they are a formidable combination, but this is a game from which we simply must extract full points. With only six points to our credit after ten matches we can't afford to sacrifice any more at Haig Avenue just now, but, clearly, our boys will have to work tremendously hard to do the trick.

RESERVES GAMES. After a week's break the Reserves resume operations with a visit to Clitheroe on Saturday. It is hoped they can bring something worthwhile back from the trip. They return home on Tuesday evening next week when South Liverpool will be here in a re-arranged match. This game should have been played last Saturday but the Merseysiders were otherwise engaged in the F.A. Cup

LUTON TOWN F.C. — PEN PICTURES 1962-63

- Goalkeeper** **RON BAYNHAM.** Has been with Luton Town since 1951. Has represented England on several occasions. Played for the Football League on two occasions and also for England 'B'. Was a member of the F.A. Touring Party to South America in 1959.
- Full Back** **B. McNALLY.** Can occupy either full back position. Came from the League of Ireland Club, Shelbourne and has been with Luton since May, 1956. Played for Eire 'B' versus Rumania in Dublin in 1957 and also for Eire versus Czechoslovakia.
- Full Back** **JOHN BRAMWELL.** Joined Luton from Everton when Billy Bingham, the Irish International was transferred to that club in October 1960. Is a very capable player and worthy to be considered for International honours.
- Wing Half or Centre Forward** **R. MORTON.** Played for England 'B' versus Switzerland 'B' team, the Football Combination versus the Dutch XI (on two occasions) and also for the Football Association versus the Army. Reserve for England at Wembley in 1955 and against Ireland in 1958.
- Centre Half** **RON COPE.** Signed from Manchester United just before the opening of the 1961/62 season. Signed as an Amateur in 1950, turning Professional in 1951. Was an England Schoolboy International. Made 150 appearances for Manchester United's First Team.
- Wing Half** **D. PACEY.** Born in Luton, signed for the Club in 1956. Has played for the F.A. versus the R.A.F. and was also a member of the England Under 23 team against Germany and Italy. Very strong player with a liking for getting among the goalkeepers.
- Outside Right** **D. CLAPTON.** Signed last week from Arsenal. English International having played against Wales in 1959.
- Inside Forward** **JAMES FLEMING.** Came to Luton from Partick Thistle when we transferred Joe McBride, in November 1960. Is a very capable player with a tremendous shot and good turn of speed.
- Centre or Inside Forward** **G. TURNER.** Came to Luton as a Wing Half upon his demob from the Navy but found his true position in the forward line. Represented the English League in 1955 and also played for the F.A. XI versus the Army in 1958. The Town's leading goalscorer eight seasons out of the last nine. Is a skilled player with a tremendous shot.
- Inside Forward** **T. McKECHNIE.** Born Glasgow and came here direct from Rob Roy at the end of Season 1960/61. Played consistently in the First Team last season making 36 appearances in League and Cup.
- Outside Left** **H. WALDEN.** Joined Luton from Kettering in January last year and stepped straight into the first team at Norwich, making 34 League and Cup appearances last season. Has a very forceful shot.
