From the Manager's Office . . .

Mr. JOHNNY STEELE says —

I did not see the match against Bradford myself as I was away watching a player so I have to be guided by reports.

But it seems that we were a shade unlucky not to have taken both points for in the very last minute of all we had a goal disallowed which came as a surprise to our lads.

It was, as could be expected, a hard fought Yorkshire Derby game, and of course, an away draw is always a most useful accomplishment.

To go through five games without defeat as we have now done speaks volumes for the enthusiasm and craft which the lads have been pouring into their play.

One of the things which pleases me most of all is the better balance which is coming through as the side settles down.

There is much more rhythm and unity as the moves are built up from goal. Perhaps with more steadiness in front of goal our victories would have been greater.

But there can be no question that the last string of home games have produced not only plenty of good football but plenty of thrills.

Just the thing in fact to bring back the crowds. And this is what has been happening as we saw from the fact that our last home game — against Coventry City — produced the top 'gate' of the season at Oakwell so far, 8,925.

We mean to keep up this sort of football so that we can confidently expect ever growing support.

Luton Town

Founded in 1885 by the amalgamation of Wanderers and Excelsior, Luton Town were the pioneers of professional football in the south of England, employing paid players as early as 1891.

Elected to the Football League Division II in 1897, the "Hatters" failed to gain re-election in 1900. But they re-entered in the Third Division in 1920.

Goalkeeper **RON BAYNHAM** joined from Worcester City in 1951, and has represented England on several occasions. He was a member of the F.A. touring party to South America in 1959.

BRENDAN McNALLY, right back, came from the League of Ireland club Shelbourne and has been with Luton since May 1956.

Left back **JOHN BRAMWELL** was one of the two players obtained by Luton from Everton when Irish international Billy Bingham was transferred to the Merseyside club.

BOB MORTON, right half, is a local product who has played for both England "B" and the Football Combination.

Centre half **D. PACEY** has played for the England Under-23 team, and is a strong player with an aptitude for goal-scoring.

ALWYN McGUFFIE, left half is an excellent distributor of the ball, having been with Luton since September 1954.

Right winger **DANNY CLAPTON** is a recent signing from Arsenal at a large fee. Has an England cap and has settled down with Luton.

JIM FLEMING, inside right arrived from Partick Thistle when Joe McBride was transferred.

Centre forward **JACK LORNIE** is an Aberdonian who arrived from Leicester City. Has converted from inside man to centre forward.

Another Scot inside left **McKECHNIE**. Glasgow born he made 36 first team appearances last year.

HARRY WALDEN, outside left stepped straight into the senior side when he joined from Kettering in January last year.

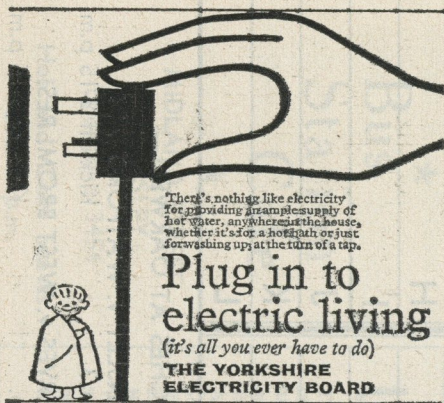

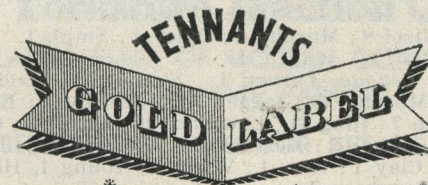
Just another mention now that some of our old friends are returning to Oakwell about the selling of our jackpot tickets.
