



Club Notes

RESULTS during these last few weeks have been most encouraging giving us much hope that the corner has been turned and that at last we can look forward to better days. We felt that if we could avoid defeat at Norwich last week (this is not negative thinking) such hopes would be justified. We did avoid defeat, and the fact that we should have won the match gives us the encouragement to look ahead with confidence. The future could be quite thrilling as our lads are playing at the present time, especially with in the near future a F.A. Cup match at home which should see us through into Round 4 at least.

We extend a warm welcome to Grimsby Town to-day, who are finding the going on their return to the Second Division not at all to their liking. Suffering relegation at the end of the 1958/59 season they were back again after three seasons in the Third, being fellow-travellers with Portsmouth. Last Saturday they lost at home to Chelsea by three clear goals, quite a drubbing which no doubt they will try to put right to-day.

We have been drawn against Swindon Town in the Third Round of the F.A. Cup to be played at Luton on January 5th next, when a ding-dong struggle can fully be expected. At present lying in seventh place in the Third Division they feel, following their home win over Reading 4-2 in the First Round and another splendid win at Yeovil last Saturday in the Second Round by two goals to nil that they have a good chance of getting their own back on us for the defeat we handed out to them by three goals to one here in February, 1952 in

the Fifth Round of the Cup. Our team that day was — Streten; Cooke, Aherne; Morton, Hall, Watkins; Davies, Taylor, J. Moore. Stobart, Mitchell. Taylor (2) and Davies were our scorers.

Tickets for the match on January 5th will be ready as from next Saturday, December 8th. Prices will be Main Stand 7/6, Enclosure 5/- Enclosure (Boys) 2/6. Entrance to all other parts of the Ground will be by payment at the Turnstiles. Bobbers Stand 4/- (Boys) 2/-; Terraces 3/-, (Boys) 1/6. This season we have just under 1,000 Season Ticket Holders so that we are able for the first time to allow two Tickets per Holder if applied for. The extra ticket will not be for the adjoining seat if already taken up by a Season Ticket Holder, but every endeavour will be taken to allocate a ticket for a seat as near to the Reserved Season seat as possible. Tickets can be obtained at the Office, 70 Kenilworth Road or by postal application accompanied by a stamped and addressed envelope with remittance. Season Ticket Holders must produce the Blue Slip for Round 3 out of their Season Ticket Book when applying, and application is requested by Saturday, December 29th otherwise the seat will be available to the general public.

Our Reserve team is going great guns these days following a very shaky beginning to the season. They have won their last five matches, scoring ten goals and only one against. They today occupy third position with the same number of points as Crystal Palace in third position who enjoy a .01 better goal average over us. Considering that three matches have been lost at home this season,

against Notts. Forest, Crystal Palace and Bristol Rovers (only the first one of which should have been the case) we consider this team, comprised mostly of youngsters, has done very well indeed. Playing to-day against bottom of the Table Notts. County at the County Ground our lads should strengthen their position and so be ready for their match with Leicester Reserves here next Saturday.

Next Saturday also kick-off 11 a.m. the Luton Schoolboys will be playing against Barnet Schoolboys in the Divisional Final of the English Schools' Shield Competition. Last Saturday our local Boys beat the North Leicestershire Boys by three clear goals which was a really

splendid performance. There was much good football from both sides. What a great pity there are not more people coming to see these lads play, only 208 here last Saturday (apart from those tickets sold to schoolchildren during the week). The Officials of the Luton Schools F.A. find such response not very encouraging, to say the least, but all being so interested in the lads they keep pegging away hoping there will be a revival of interest in school football and so help them feel their efforts have not been wasted.

Also on Monday night next, December 10th, kick-off 7.15 p.m. our Youth side will be playing Oxford United in the Second Round of the F.A. Youth Cup. Gates at Maple Road and Kenilworth

Road entrances to the Enclosure and Stand will be opened. Admission 1/- Boys 6d. Again we can promise you some very entertaining football.

for Deaf Children of the Midlands. The Appeal is for £7,500 to provide a full-sized playing field at the School in Edgbaston. All of you here to-day will no doubt have heard of Joe Mercer. Here is an opportunity to hear him speak.

We would like to congratulate The Luton Youth Band on their rendering here a fortnight ago, their first public performance. They did very well, there was a nice balance of harmony allied to quite a bit of skill in performance, and their Conductor, Mr. E. Charles Sweby, deserves full credit for bringing about such a high standard.

Don Donovan (right back). The veteran of the team at 32 but still quick enough to give most wingers a run for their money. Signed from Everton four years ago for a substantial fee. Won caps for Eire.

Brian Keeble (left back). A young player with more than 120 League games to his name. After 'demob' from the Services he made rapid progress from the club's junior teams and when pressed into the senior side at centre half in an emergency, showed enough to earn very quickly a regular place in defence.

Keith Jobling (centre half). A lean built but sturdy pivot who graduated through the Club's nursery sides. Made his 200th appearance for the Mariners on May 1 last season in the game in which Grimsby beat Brentford 2-0 to clinch promotion.

Ron Cockerill (left half). Tall, long-striding Yorkshireman. Signed from Huddersfield three seasons ago. Though signed as a centre half, prefers wing half. A constructive player he packs a powerful wallop in his right foot.

Fred Jones (outside right). A game, lively winger with plenty of enthusiasm. Scored eight goals in 41 games last term. Joined Grimsby from Swindon after serving with Brighton and Arsenal. A Welsh Under 23 International.

Cliff Portwood (inside right). A nippy ball player whose role is that of schemer though he can score goals. Got 24 for Port Vale two seasons ago and 14 for Grimsby last season.

Ron Rafferty (inside left). Plays a roaming centre forward's game though he is usually on the spot for the high crosses. An ex-Portsmouth man, Ron is in his sixth term with Grimsby. So far has scored 138 goals in 234 games


