



**Club Notes**

ANOTHER disappointing blow was dealt us last Saturday when again we were defeated away from home by the narrowest of margins in a game which we could have won, in fact should have won and we feel would have won if we had been able to field a full side for the whole ninety minutes. McNally, injured after only half an hour's play, took very little effective part in the rest of the match so that we were left with a four-man attack for two-thirds of the game. Even so we should have won but again it is just that final snap after good approach work that is lacking. To lose by an only goal away from home is no disgrace but unfortunately the position is getting so desperate that even this is no crumb of comfort. McNally's injury prevents him playing this evening so Bramwell, who has been playing very well in the Reserves these last four matches, is brought in again at left back and Daniel moves over to the right. Chandler is also injured which has meant a reshuffling of the forward line.

We have the pleasure of receiving the lads from Middlesbrough here this evening and extend to them a warm welcome. On the day we should have met them they were engaged at home with Leeds United in the Fourth Round of the F.A. Cup, losing by two goals to nil. The Boro' lost at home again last Saturday to Southampton, being beaten by two goals to one, a very disappointing result for them especially for their new Manager Raich Carter who has joined them from Mansfield Town with whom he had been very successful. Our one "away" victory to

date was at the expense of Middlesbrough so that we fully expect them here tonight not only determined to prevent us gaining our first "double" of the season but to try and wipe out to some extent the very disappointing results they have experienced these last two Saturdays.

We have at last been able to finalize new dates for our postponed matches both for the First and Reserve teams. The matches now arranged to be played at Kenilworth Road for the remainder of the season are shown on page 5.

Our Reserves rather surprisingly fell from grace last Saturday when having to admit defeat to Cardiff City Reserves. After the splendid show here a fortnight ago when our lads beat Arsenal second string they went to Shrewsbury and shared four goals, and then last Tuesday went to Bristol Rovers and again drew, sharing the six goals scored. It was fully expected therefore that we would see them have a nice win here last Saturday but Cardiff, in their first attack on our goal scored and then scored a very fortunate goal to put them two up which proved too much for our lads to pull back against the strong Cardiff defence.
