Club Notes

WHAT a joy it was to see that splendid entertainment here last Monday evening when, in a match of many phases, all of them exciting, we ran out worthy winners against Middlesbrough to pull off our first double of the season. It was a great pity that the stretcher incident was allowed in some national newspapers to be considered the highlight of the evening, thus taking away the praise to which surely our lads were fully entitled, but we are quite sure that the vast majority of the 6,431 present were of one accord in that they had seen a wonderful game of football. All the four goals scored by our lads were in the thrilling class, particularly the first, second and fourth and again we repeat particularly the fourth — a great goal if ever there was one. Harry Walden in pain in the Dressing Room nearly fainted when he heard that Middlesbrough had drawn level, but when he heard the roar which greeted our fourth goal all his pain was forgotten in his excitement. Although the injury he received is very serious and will undoubtedly keep him out of action for the rest of the season it is not as bad as at first feared for nothing was broken. He was married this morning in Northampton — we wish him much happiness and success in his future partnership.

The win against Middlesbrough was very pleasing indeed, but what pleased Manager Harvey just as much was the wonderful enthusiasm of the crowd throughout the match, and particularly the ovations given as the players left the field at half-time and at the end. It was all most encouraging, which makes the Manager feel he is getting somewhere at last. There is no doubt that the players

themselves respond to such enthusiasm, so let us have more of it, lots of it, and so help in getting away from our present precarious position at the bottom of the Table.

Newcastle United are our guests this afternoon, the mighty lads of the Tyne, to whom we extend a warm welcome. Much money has been spent by Newcastle in an attempt to get together a promotion seeking team but somehow it is not yet quite there. When we played at St. James' Park last November 10th to be beaten by three goals to one Newcastle were only four points behind the leaders, just nicely placed at that time of the season. A month went by however before they could record their next win by which time they were seven points behind the leaders, which was precisely the state of affairs last Saturday evening after Newcastle had beaten Chelsea. A home match last Wednesday evening with Grimsby Town was fully expected to reduce the gap to five points, but after enjoying most of the play, missing a penalty and hitting the posts twice the United had to be contented with one point in a goalless draw to the great frustration of their twenty-seven thousand supporters present. What a match this one we have with them to-day can be! We hope it lives up to its prospects.

Our new Director, Mr. Len Hawkins, we are pleased to note has accepted the position of Chairman of the Bobbers Stand Club and Mr. Jock Robertson the position of Treasurer. Both are enthusiastic workers, and with the help of the Committee, are hoping that the several ideas at present being worked out that the Bobbers Club will be looked upon as the social centre for the district.

PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

Dave Hollins (Goalkeeper). Secured from Brighton and Hove to make his debut against Spurs to hit the headlines with a great display. Young and capable, he is rated as certain to be capped for Wales.

Bill McKinney (full back). Another strong defender of top class. A local discovery

Dick Keith (full back). Irish International signed from Linfield. Capped for Ireland regularly and has been a tower of defensive strength for United over several seasons.

George Dalton (full back or wing half). A local youngster rated by United as one of the best wing half back prospects in the game. Fast making top grade.

Duncan Neale (half back). Born at Ilford and joined Newcastle as a junior from his local club Ilford. A useful man in attack.

John McGrath (centre half). Signed from Bury for £30,000 plus Bobby Stokoe. "Under 23" International. Born in Manchester. Hefty and strong in the tackle.

James Iley (half back). Signed from Nottingham Forest early this season for a substantial fee. Previously with Tottenham Hotspur.

Alan Suddick (outside right). Will find a place in the hearts of all sportsmen who love a good ball player. Only 18 years of age, a local boy who came up through the Nursery side.

Dave Hilly (inside forward). Close season signing from Third Lanark for a fee of around £30,000. Aged 23 he is already a Scottish "Under 23" International. A great ball player as much at home at inside right as outside right.

Barrie Thomas (centre forward). Signed from Scunthorpe for a fee of around £40,000. The fastest man in the game say the fans, and they could be right. A great opportunist with a power drive in either foot and a brilliant header of the ball. Given the right service he is ever a match winner.

Ron McGarry (inside forward). Played for Workington at the same time as Newcastle's manager Joe Harvey was there. Subsequently went to Bolton and later was signed by Newcastle for a five figure fee.

Jimmy Fell (outside left). Yet another recent signing, coming from Everton for a substantial fee. Is already a favourite with the Geordies and has proved himself a good buy. Great things are expected of Fell this season. Has a good turn of speed and craft.


