



Club Notes

AFTER our quite successful Easter effort in which we obtained four points out of the possible six we went to Grimsby last Saturday in the hope that defeat would at least be avoided. Our hopes were greatly raised when Ron Davies opened the scoring in the 27th minute but alas two minutes later Grimsby were level and two further goals by them without reply by us meant another defeat chalked up against us. These two points gained by Grimsby could be the means of them avoiding relegation for they now have a four point lead over ourselves and it now looks as if the fight against the drop is between Charlton Athletic, Walsall and ourselves with only one of us not playing in the Third Division next season. We have on paper, by far the better chance of avoiding doing so for out of our remaining seven matches five of them are at home whereas Charlton have three home fixtures and Walsall two. The remaining programme of those two teams are :

CHARLTON

At home — to Newcastle United (played last evening). Derby County and Southampton.

Away to — Rotherham United, Scunthorpe United, Luton and Walsall.

WALSALL

At home — to Norwich City and Charlton Athletic (Walsall's last two matches).

Away to — Derby County, Bury, Grimsby, Rotherham and Newcastle United.

It is interesting to note that the last match of either team is against each other, at Walsall on Tuesday, 21st May.

We hope that our fate for next season does not hang on the result of that match, but what a match it could be!

We welcome Cardiff City to our Ground this evening in a League II fixture originally arranged to be played on March 2nd but which had to be postponed because of the bad weather. Last Saturday at home to Sunderland this team won handsomely by five goals to two, quite a performance against such strong opposition. It was a victory well deserved on the play and certainly shows that the Cardiff forwards know where the goal lies. Their record of 72 goals scored so far this season in the 35 matches played fully bears this out. We always witness some good football when Cardiff play here. We trust this evening proves no exception.

Our Reserves beat Norwich Reserves here last Saturday, doing very well to beat a team with so much talent. Time and again after much good approach work our forwards were just prevented from opening the scoring, but two well-taken goals in the second half by Clarke and Brennan ensured victory although Norwich scored to reduce the arrears with just over five minutes left for play.

Our Youth team also last Saturday did very well when they beat the Tottenham lads on their own Ground by three goals to two. At Stockingstone Road the previous Saturday they had inflicted defeat on the Tottenham lads by the same score, so that our youngsters have the distinction of having taken four points off the Tottenham lads this season. These two wins in particular should give our lads much confidence for the future.

PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

Graham Vearncombe (goalkeeper). Cardiff boy, Welsh International, has been with Cardiff from youth days. Graduated from the local schoolboy team and Cardiff City has been his only first class club. Twice capped for Wales and reserve on many occasions.

Ron Stitfall (right back). The longest serving member of the Cardiff City team. Among the many local products at Ninian Park, Stitfall was signed as an outside right, at the age of 14, during the war years. He signed professional in 1947, and moved into the rearguard with such success that, apart from a few outings as leader of the attack, he has subsequently remained there. Stitfall won his first Welsh International Cap against England in 1953, and has represented the Principality in games with Continental teams.

Alan Harrington (wing half or full back). Yet another product of local football and born at Cogan, a stone's throw from Ninian Park. Has had a brilliant career since making the first team in 1951. Has been capped on numerous occasions for Wales. A splendid clubman.

Colin Baker (wing half). Born in Cardiff. One of our famous local products who succeeded an equally famous international namesake Billy Baker, when he made his debut in the League side in 1953. Plays with equal efficiency on either flank. Capped for Wales since 1959 and also played twice for Wales under 23 eleven.

Frank Rankmore (centre half). A most improved player. Has been with the Club for five seasons and made the centre half position his own after the departure of Danny Malloy to Doncaster. Previously played for Cardiff Corinthians

as an amateur. Capped twice for the Wales under 23 eleven.

Barry Hole (wing half or inside forward). Son of former Swansea Town and Welsh International Billy Hole, he is another product of Swansea. Made a sensational debut in first team at 17 years of age three seasons ago and has a wonderful future in professional football.

Derek Tapscott (inside right). A native of Barry, South Wales, Tapscott was with his home town club before moving to Highbury in 1953. He was given his first senior outing in the following April, when we were the visitors to Highbury and scored two goals in that game. This was the game in which Joe Mercer sustained the broken leg which ended his playing career. A Welsh International, with 17 Caps.

Peter Hooper (outside left). Recent signing from Bristol Rovers for whom he played 9 seasons. Hails from Teignmouth in sunny Devon and was a prolific goal scorer with the Rovers. Represented the English League v. Eire.

Mel Charles (centre forward). Learnt his football with Swansea Boys, eventually signing as a professional for Swansea Town. Transferred to Arsenal for a considerable fee and played with them for 3 seasons, joining Cardiff City in the middle of last season. A very versatile player and he can play at either half back or forward. Has represented Wales on 33 occasions.

Ivor Allchurch (inside left). Welsh International of many Caps needs little introduction. Has been one of Wales outstanding inside forwards in League football for many seasons. Started his career with Swansea Town and joined Newcastle four years ago.
