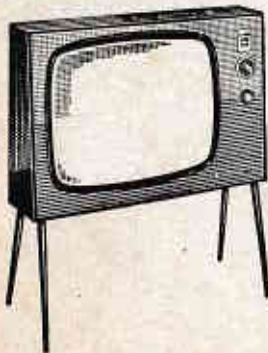

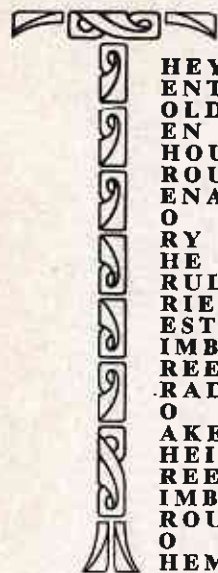

### Club Notes

WHAT a rousing reception our lads would have received at the end of the match last Wednesday evening if they had walked off the field undefeated. The encouragement given them especially in the second half when it was realised our lads were putting every effort in their endeavours to at least draw level with the Cardiff lads was wonderful to behold and show that those supporters who still attend are very keen and alive in their support. The pulled muscle suffered by Gordon Turner midway through the first half proved too much of a handicap however against the City's strong defence which fought every inch of the way, on top of which the three goals Cardiff scored were all in the "gift" class or practically so. The first, from a splendid shot by Hooper the Cardiff Outside Left from well out was accidentally diverted by Alan Daniel out of Ron Baynham's reach. The second goal, also by Hooper and again well out seemed to be passing outside the far post but somehow curled at the last moment to strike the inside of the upright and so into the net. Ron Baynham had not even handled the ball in play and yet here we were two goals down. Just after this Gordon Turner pulled a muscle which left him a passenger for the rest of the match and the position looked black indeed, but a splendidly taken goal by Ron Davies just before half time raised our hopes only to be dashed down again again immediately on resumption when a harmless looking ball which Bob Morton appeared to have well covered suddenly passed him to the unmarked Hooper who just had to hit the ball into the net,

to complete his hat-trick. This seemed to be the last straw, for after all how much continued bad luck can a team take. Great credit to our lads however for after a few minutes they began to come more into the game and, greatly encouraged by the crowd, actually took a grip on the game which continued until the final whistle. Tommy McKechnie when just on the point of shooting was brought down and from the spot Alan Daniel made no mistake to bring us within one goal of drawing level. Renewed efforts were made by our lads and a hard cross by Mike Fairchild after good approach work, even against such an experienced player as Ron Stiffall, looked as if Ron Davies would connect but he appeared to be held back from reaching the ball just that vital second which allowed the ball to cross the face of the goal. Had he connected he would undoubtedly have scored, but there it was. Full marks to our lads for their wonderful effort against such odds. Turner's injury prevents him playing this afternoon, and at the time these Notes were being prepared Tommy McKechnie was also very doubtful. This on top of the other injured players Harry Walden, John Groves, Jack Lornie and Freddy Jardine especially at this time of the season's programme, this is quite serious, but we keep pegging along.

That defeat by Cardiff means that we have lost 9 matches this season by the odd goal, and with the seven drawn means that in sixteen matches that other goal has made a tremendous difference to our position in the League Table. The highest number of goals scored against us in any match is three, and not once have we been beaten by more than a two-goal margin.

**David MacLaren** (goalkeeper). Signed from Leicester City in May, 1960. Was with Leicester for 3 seasons, formerly with Dundee F.C. Born Auchterarder, Perthshire.

**John Leiper** (goalkeeper). Joined the staff in March 1958 from Aberdeen East End F.C. Made his first team debut at the end of 1960-61 season.

**Michael Reeves** (full back). A product of local football. Signed as a professional in April, 1960. Made his first team debut this season against Swansea Town at Home Park, on November 24th, 1962. Born Saltash, Cornwall.

**Richard Davis** (full back). Another player who commenced his career with Argyle as an amateur. Signed as an apprentice professional August 1960, and full time in November 1961. Made his debut recently versus Derby County. Plymouth born.
