

### Club Notes

WHAT NOW? Following Charlton's defeat at Scunthorpe last Monday evening which evened up the number of matches each of the three bottom Clubs had played and had left all three level pegging on points but ourselves in third place because of a better goal average we eagerly awaited the result last Wednesday evening of Walsall's match at Newcastle. When the result did come through the question was asked what now? It looks at the moment as if we shall have to obtain maximum points from our three remaining matches to make absolutely sure of staying put in the Second Division. This would be bad enough but when all three are of such a vital nature, one of the Clubs like ourselves, fighting against relegation and the other two making every effort in their bid for promotion, we have indeed a fight on our hands. And on top of all this we have serious injury problems which deprive us of the services of several of our players. Harry Walden, Dave Pacey are definitely out for the rest of the season, and there were doubts when these Notes were being prepared last Thursday evening of Mat Brennan, Mark Lownds, Tommy McKechnie and Ron Davies being unfit but it was expected the two latter players would be reported fit in time for this match. There will be much scanning of the results in many places when matches have been played for there are many problems of promotion and relegation still to be solved before the last ball is kicked off this very momentous season. Let us hope the position of Luton Town has been in no way worsened at the end of to-day's play.

Charlton have two matches to play after to-day's match next Saturday at

home to Southampton and the last one at Walsall on Tuesday, 21st May. Walsall also have two more matches to play to complete their programme but are not playing to-day. The first is at home to Norwich City next Tuesday, May 14th and the other is the fixture at home to Charlton already referred to. With so much at stake all these matches should be worth watching.

Our opponents to-day, whom we welcome once more to Kenilworth Road have like ourselves, had a very disappointing season. And yet they have won as many matches away from home as Stoke the present leaders! These were at Cardiff City, Derby County, Norwich City and Rotherham United. If we could boast the same "away" record we would not now be wondering the results of several matches being played over the next few days. We remember very vividly Charlton's last visit to this Ground, when contrary to all expectations, they not only won but beat us by no less than six goals to one. Their team was—

Duff ; Sewell, Hewie ; Tocknell, Hinton, Bailey ; White, Matthews, Leary, Edwards and Kinsey. Scorers Edwards (3), Leary, Kinsey, and one own goal. Our team that day, to refresh your memories, was Baynham ; McNally, Bramwell ; Groves, Cope, Pacey ; Walden, Ashworth, Turner, McKechnie and Legate. Scorer Turner. With practically the same team on both sides we had won our match at The Valley earlier in the season by one goal to nil. The surprise outcome of the return match at Luton still lingers in the memory.

## PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

**Frank Reed** (goalkeeper). Signed from Murton Colliery (Wearside League) in 1954. Made League debut against West Bromwich, February, 1956. A former Blacksmith's Striker.

**John Sewell** (Full Back). Played for England at Rugby as a schoolboy and was also a keen sprinter. Signed for Charlton in 1955, and shone at half-back before taking over at full-back. Made 41 League appearances last season.

**John Hewie** (left back). South African born, but has many times played for Scotland. His parents are of Scottish descent. Signed in 1949 and has occupied eight different positions for Charlton.

**Fred Lucas** (wing half or inside forward). Another local player who gained honours as a schoolboy. Former Kent cricketer.

**Brian Tocknell** (Half Back). A South African from Pretoria who quickly played his way into Charlton's League team. A South African International.

**Marvin Hinton** (Half Back). Another Londoner. Captained Charlton's Colts before becoming a professional in 1957. Twice played for England Under 23's team last season.

**Brian Kinsey** (Winger). Former Bromley amateur, who was born close to the Valley. Signed as professional in October, 1956, and came bang to the front last season, making 41 appearances.

**Roy Matthews** (Inside Forward). Born at Slough, but learned his football at Arbroath, Scotland. Joined Charlton as a junior, signing professional in April, 1957. Made his League debut in April 1960.

**Jack Kennedy** (inside forward). Secured last season from the Scottish club, Saltcoats Victoria. Made his League debut a month later.

**Keith Peacock** (inside forward). Born within a few miles of The Valley, only 17 years ago. Made rapid progress in Charlton's junior sides and became a professional during the close season.

**Michael Kenning** (Winger). Cost Charlton a big fee when they secured him from Shrewsbury Town early in November. A native of Birmingham, previously played for Aston Villa.
