**Club Notes**

HERE we are at the commencement of yet another season wondering, as usual, what the gods have in store for us but hoping, as always, that it is going to be a successful season full of good football, entertaining to watch with plenty of excitement. The way our lads have tackled their pre-season training gives us all much hope as to the outcome of the season's endeavours and we shall be very surprised if we are not knocking at the door of promotion as the present season nears its end. Each Club of course begins with such hopes for without it what is the good of preparation and endeavour, but we at Kenilworth Road do feel that with the improvements which we hope have been made in several positions success will follow. It is certainly a very stiff commencement to a season to have to face three away matches out of the first four, but we are looking upon it as a challenge and if we do well in those four matches then the stage is set for a successful run which would in turn bring back the many hundreds of people who at one time were our ardent supporters. Those of you here to-day can take a hand in that successful beginning by giving the lads your full encouragement. We on our part are sure the players we have can give us success if they are encouraged to do so. Let us HEAR that encouragement.

We are not able to give you a short history of the Walsall players in our Programme to-day as we have not received the necessary details to do so, and so we take the opportunity of including our own players in the space usually provided for the Pen Portraits

of our visitors. We would like, however, to extend a warm welcome here to our newcomers Gordon Fincham, Alan McBain, Gareth Salisbury, and Colin Tinsley, while not forgetting two youngsters who have signed as Apprentice Professionals since last we met — Christopher Long and Bruce Riach. We trust they have already found their feet here in Luton and that they will be very happy here.

Our visitors for this opening game of the season are also our partners in the big drop from last season, but nevertheless we extend to them again a warm welcome to Kenilworth Road. We took three points from them last season, which we trust is a good sign for to-day's game, but we remember quite well our match with them here when we won by the narrow margin of four goals to three after enjoying a lead of four goals to one early in the second half. We would like to see as many goals again to-day (providing we finish on the right side!) and as thrilling an encounter.

In our efforts to bring more money into the Club coffers we have decided to replace our own Pool activities by one on a wider scale, details of which are given elsewhere in this Programme. We are, however, continuing with our own Lottery effort, that is, the Lucky Number Tickets, which are proving quite successful. Each of the two systems will appeal in different ways, and therefore we feel one will not detract from the other. Other Clubs have two such systems which they find are working very well, and so we decided to do the same. After all the prospect of winning £2.500 for an outlay of 6d. is very stimulating. ## PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR PLAYERS

**Ron Baynham** (goalkeeper). Has been with Luton Town since 1951. Was secured from Worcester City. He has represented England on several occasions. Played for the Football League on 2 occasions and also for England 'B' versus Yugoslavia 'B'. Was a member of the F.A. Touring team to South America in 1959.

**Alan Daniel** (full back). A player of considerable promise who gained a place in the First team last season. Signed Professional for Luton in January 1958, when 18. Son of Mel Daniel who played for us during and immediately after the war.

**Alan McBain** (full back). Born in Aberdeen. Played for Carlisle last season when he attracted the Manager's attention. Transferred to Luton in exchange for J. Lornie and A. Ross. A very sound and capable defender.

**John Bramwell** (full back). Joined Luton in October 1960 from Everton and has proved a very capable player worthy to be considered for International honours. Played at wing half on several occasions last season, proving equally successful.

**Bob Morton** (wing half). Local born and has been with the Club since 1948. Played for England 'B' once and The Football Combination versus the Dutch XL on 2 occasions. Also for the F.A. versus The Army. Was chosen as Reserve for England at Wembley in 1955 and again when they played Ireland in 1958. Has played in most positions for Luton.

**Gordon Fincham** (centre half). Transferred from Leicester to Plymouth 4 years ago and then to Luton in July 1963. Is the dominating centre half we hope will strengthen our defence.

**David Pacey** (wing half). Born in Luton signed for the Club in 1956. Has played for the F.A. versus the R.A.F. and was also a member of the England under 23 team against Germany and Italy. Very strong player with a liking for getting among the goalscorers.

**Harry Walden** (outside right). Joined Luton from Kettering in January 1961 and stepped straight into the First Team. Severely injured at a crucial part of last season's programme which prevented him from taking any further part in the struggle against relegation. It is hoped he has lost none of his skill as a result of that injury.

**Gordon Turner** (centre or inside forward). Came to Luton as a wing half upon his demob. from the Navy but found his true position in the No. 8 shirt. Represented the English League against the Scottish League in 1955 and also played for the F.A. XI versus the Army in 1958. The Town's leading goalscorer for eight seasons, he is a skilled player with a tremendous shot.

**Ron Davies** (centre forward). Obtained from Chester in October 1962 and was an immediate success. Scored 21 goals, including 4 against Norwich City at Luton last April. His performances created much interest for the Wales Under 23 team.

**Gareth Salisbury** (inside forward). Played for Norwich City last season. When we found he was not being retained we immediately jumped in and signed him. Can play forward or half back, but prefers to be up front.

**Fred Jardine** (outside left). Born in Edinburgh. Played for Dundee for two seasons before coming to Luton at the end of season 1960-61. Has shown promise since he arrived here.
