**Club Notes**

ALTHOUGH we lost our League match last Saturday against Coventry City we certainly did not disgrace ourselves despite the fact that we found ourselves two goals down very early in the game. We were all very surprised that the second goal was allowed to stand for Humphries was at least two yards offside when the ball was passed to him, but what pleased us was the fact that our lads, even with two such body blows after only six minutes' play, did not give up the fight but put everything they could into their game and the Coventry defence was hard put to on several occasions to keep their goals "against" column from being increased. There were a lot of "Ifs" about the game, for instance IF Jimmy Weir had scored in that first minute, IF the Referee had not allowed that second goal, IF Harry Walden had put the ball into the open net when he had beaten the goalkeeper to the ball midway through the first half, IF the third goal by Coventry had been prevented (and what a lucky goal it was —from their first real attack of the second half — and so on, a very different story could have been told for we were undoubtedly on top during the second half until that last goal was scored. However it was a game full of incident and excitement, and if we could expect such a game every Saturday then we are quite sure a lot more people would be attending Kenilworth Road than has been the case these last two seasons or so.

Our visitors this evening are the Crystal Palace Club, to whom we extend a very warm welcome. The last time

we met the Palace was way back in the 1936/37 Season, the season we gained promotion to the Second Division, our paths not having since crossed until to-day. The Palace were one of the original members, like ourselves, when the Third Division (South) was formed Season 1920/21, and in that first season they were Champions and thus gained promotion to the Second Division. They were members of the Second Division for the four seasons 1921/22 to 1924/25, returning to the Third the following season. They suffered a further set-back at the end of the 1957/58 season for finding themselves in the lower half of the Third Division they became members of the newly-formed Fourth Division in 1958/59. After only three seasons however they were back in the Third Division, and so we meet again after an absence of 27 years. At present in eighth place in the Table with seven points from the six matches played to date, they are lying in a nice position, their three goals to nil victory at home to Shrewsbury last Saturday being a very good performance. We notice Ronnie Allen was amongst the scorers last Saturday, even though it was from a penalty. His experience is proving very valuable.

We express regret that our new Floodlight Installation will not be in operation for to-night's match. Work on it is proceeding as quickly as possible now that we have received the Towers. These were altered from the original specification which has meant more for the erectors, the bases being 1 foot 6 inches larger and heavier than prepared for. We are hoping the new Lights will

## PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

**Bill Glazier** (goalkeeper). Born at Nottingham, Bill joined the Palace ground staff in 1961 and signed professional the same year. Has represented the F.A. Youth XI. Last season he proved himself a fearless and very safe keeper and is now seriously attracting the attention of the Under 23 Selectors. Made his League debut in January 1962.

**Terry Long** (full back or wing half). Signed in 1955 from Wycombe Wanderers and born in Bucks., Terry is a versatile and consistent player having been a regular member of the Palace 1st XI for the last seven seasons making over 300 appearances. He is the Club's longest serving player and his ambition is to play for Palace in the 2nd Division.

**Don Townsend** (full back or wing half). Born at Swindon, Don moved to the Palace in 1962 after 12 years with Charlton. He is the complete footballer and is serving his new Club well. Has made over 300 League and Cup appearances.

**George Petchey** (wing half). Transferred from Q.P.R. in 1960, George started his career at West Ham. He has been a regular member of our 1st XI since joining the Palace and played an important part in our promotion from Division 4 in 1961. A Senior F.A. Coach, George also helps to coach the youngsters.

**Brian Wood** (centre half). Since joining Palace from W.B.A. in 1961, Brian has progressed to become one of the best pivots in the 3rd Division. Tall, strong and reliable, Brian is also being closely watched by the International Selectors.

**Bert Howe** (wing half or full back). Born at Charlton, Bert first signed professional in 1958. National Service interrupted his career but since his demob in 1962 he has become one of our most improved players. His consistent, reliable and determined play has made him feared by many opposing forwards.

**Eddie Werge** (winger). Has represented London Youths and Kent Schools. Was

a professional with Charlton for 6 years before joining Palace in 1961. Another versatile player, reckoned last season to be one of the best wingers in the 3rd Division, yet can play equally well at wing half or inside forward.

**Cliff Holton** (inside forward). Born at Oxford, Cliff is one of Soccer's great personalities. Played for the Arsenal for 11 years and appeared at Wembley in the Cup Final when Arsenal played with ten men in 1952. Transferred to Watford in 1958 and helped them in their promotion from Division 4. Moved to Northampton in 1961 and was top goalscorer for them. Joined Palace in December 1962. Cliff has now scored around 250 League and Cup goals and made over 500 appearances.

**Dickie Dowsett** (centre forward). Dickie joined Palace at the same time as Cliff Holton, with points in desperate need. He immediately made an impression with his unselfish play, and 100% effort. Has scored around 100 goals and made over 250 League and Cup appearances. A regular goal getter and a handful for most centre halves. Born at Chelmsford, Dickie was previously with Spurs (3 years), Southend (1 year), Southampton (1 year) and Bournemouth (5 years).

**Peter Burridge** (inside forward). Transferred from Millwall in 1962 where he captained the Lions in their promotion from Division 4. Previously with Leyton Orient and born at Harlow. A prolific goalscorer and a nightmare to goalkeepers, having been top marksman at his Club for the past three seasons.

**Ronnie Allen** (forward). Needs no introduction. Ronnie has played on five occasions for England and holds an F.A. Cup Winners Medal won with W.B.A. in 1954. His first Club was Port Vale but he was transferred to W.B.A. for a then record fee of £20,000. Moved to Palace in 1961 and in all has made over 500 League appearances and scored over 300 goals. Made Team Captain mid-way through last season. A good coach and Professional Footballers Golf Champion twice.


