Club Notes

LOOKING back on last Wednesday's game against Port Vale, one can feel a sense of satisfaction on two counts. Firstly, the new Floodlighting system has been acclaimed by everybody as a big improvement on the old one.

Secondly it was very satisfying to see our lads strike a winning vein once again and also nice to see the ball go into the opponent's net three times, even though two of the attempts had to be disallowed because of infringements. After this and the missed penalty kick it was as if a cloud had been lifted when Jimmy Weir took that corner kick out on the right wing and lofted it high for Gordon Fincham to soar above everyone else and nod it down for Tommy McKechie to bang it over the line. The cheers and volume of support that came from the supporters following this goal was something else to be remembered. Chatting to our Manager, Mr. Bill Harvey after the game, he told me this was very sweet music to his ears, and he hopes to hear more encouragement of this kind, which will help boost morale of the team to greater heights. So keep up the good work.

Today we take pleasure in welcoming Bournemouth & Boscombe Athletic (for whom our groundsman Mr. Tom King played before transferring to Luton Town) to Kenilworth Road, after an absence of 27 years almost to the day, for it was 31st October, 1936 when they were last here and after a very keen and hard-fought game, Luton emerged the

winners by one goal to nothing. The return game at Dean Court was won by Bournemouth by two goals to our one. Bournemouth were founded in 1890 as Boscombe St. Johns, and it was in the year 1923 that they were elected to the Third Division (South). Unfortunately for them they have not yet progressed higher but if they carry on this season the way they have started, they must stand a very good chance of promotion. At the time of writing these notes, the composition of their team is not known and so we are wondering whether John Groves, who was here for many years will be on view or not. One player who will not be here is Bryn Jones, brother of Cliff (Spurs) Jones, whom I have just heard has signed for Northampton for a fee reputed to be £6,000. From all accounts he is a very good full-back.

I would like to draw your attention to what we think will be two very good games on this ground next week. On Monday evening, the 14th October our Youth Team will entertain Reading in the First Round of the Southern Junior Floodlit Cup. Kick-off 7.30 p.m. Entrance will be to the Grandstand and Enclosure only. Prices are 1/- for Adults and 6d. for Children. Our Youth team is settling down into a good combination and this game should be worth seeing. Then on Saturday morning next with a Kick-off at 11 o'clock we shall see Luton Boys playing Lea Valley Boys in the Second Round of the English Schools' Shield. This is the Luton Boys only home draw in the Preliminary Rounds this season, so those of you who enjoy watching these youngsters in action. come along next Saturday morning.
