Club Notes

THAT away victory that has escaped Luton for so long came very close to being a reality last Saturday, when our lads came away from Peterborough with one point. This is a very good feat, on a ground where few teams have been able to gain a victory during Peterborough's life in the Football League, perhaps more so when by force of injuries we had to field a weakened forward line. Although our front line failed to score a goal, they gave a good account of themselves on a very slippery surface that made foothold difficult. Full marks too, to the defence for keeping a clean score sheet, their first in an away match this season. I am told that Gordon Fincham, who spent his childhood days in Peterborough had an excellent game in front of his many friends and relatives.

Today it is our pleasure to welcome Oldham Athletic to Kenilworth Road and we feel sure we shall see a very good game if their present League position is anything to go by. They gained promotion to the Third Division at the end of last season and have simply carried on their winning ways. They were founded as long ago as 1898 as "Pine Villa" but changed their name one year later, and were elected to the Football League in 1907. They have a fine ground at Boundary Park, Oldham, where they have played before a crowd of 47,671 in one match. They have the nickname of "The Latics." At present they are managed by the former Manchester City manager, Mr. Leslie McDowall. It is also interesting to note

besides Bobby Johnstone and Bert Lister who are in their line-up today, they also have on their staff, Ken Branagan, Bill Spurdle and Colin Barlow, all of whom have also played for Manchester City. It seems like a case of home from home for them.

Turning to next Saturday, we shall be making our first appearance in the F.A. Cup this season, when we visit the Western League Team, Bridgwater. This will not be an easy game to play, but we know our lads will be going all out to make a good showing in the Cup and return to Luton victorious. If there should happen to be a replay, it will be held at Kenilworth Road on Wednesday, 20th November, kick-off 7.30 p.m. We would remind supporters that the game at Bridgwater is an all ticket one and tickets are on sale at the Office now. Prices are 4/- and 5/- standing. Seats are priced at 6/- and 7/6. Season Ticket Holders who desire seats must claim same directly after the match today. We hope to stage another interesting game here on Monday, 25th November against a German Team VFR. Kaiserslautern who will be coming over for a short tour. The kick-off will be at 7.30 p.m., and this will give our supporters yet another chance to see good opposition from abroad. We have not played a foreign team here for quite some time now, so let us hope that you will all come along and show your appreciation. Confirmation of this game will be given through the press and in our Club notes just as soon as we receive the final O.K. from our agent in Germany.

John Bollands (goalkeeper). 5 ft. 10 ins. 11 st. 7 lbs. Signed from Bolton in September 1961. Played with Oldham until 1955, when he was transferred to Sunderland, and later to Bolton. An England Under 23 International.

Barry Taylor (full back). 5 ft. 10 ins. 11 st. 6 lbs. Born in Sheffield. Another close season signing from his home town club Sheffield United. He began his career as a boy with them.

Bill Marshall (left back). 5 ft. 9 ins. 11 st. 9 lbs. Born in Belfast. Signed from Burnley in August 1962. He had nine years service with Burnley and was captain of their reserve team. An Irish Under 23 International.

Jimmy Frizzell (half back or inside forward). 5 ft. 9 ins. 11 st. 9 lbs. Born at Greenock. A hard Scottish player who was signed from Morton.

Alan Williams (centre half). 6 ft. 12 st. 2 lbs. Signed in the summer of 1961 from Bristol City his home town club. Another Under 23 player.

George Sievwright (wing half). 5 ft. 9 ins. 11 st. 4 lbs. Born in Broughty Ferry, Dundee. A close season signing from Dundee United. A very strong and hard tackling wing half.

Robert Ledger (forward). 6 ft. 12 st. Born at Craghead, Co. Durham. Signed in June 1962 from Huddersfield Town. Plays on the wing or at centre forward, and is a fine crosser of a ball.

Bobby Johnstone (inside forward). 5 ft. 7 ins. 11 st. 9 lbs. Born in Selkirk. Formerly played with Manchester City and Hibernian from where he was signed in 1960. He is a Scottish International and played at Wembley with Manchester City in 1955 and 1956.

Bert Lister (centre forward). 5 ft. 9 ins. 11 st. Born in Manchester and played with Manchester City. He signed with Ken Branagan and was the club's leading goal scorer last season.

John Colquhoun (inside forward). 5 ft. 7 ins. 11 st. 4 lbs. Signed from Stirling Albion his home town club in August 1961. A very fast and direct type of player.
