THANK goodness November has gone, must be the thought in most people's minds. The last time the team won was at home at the end of October. During November all five games played, four in the league and one in the F.A. Cup, were lost.

But last Saturday, the first in December, saw an end to all that with the 2-0 defeat of Southend. The team gave a much better showing, if you like to put it that way a vote of confidence in acting manager Mr. Alf Wood.

The two goals scored were both gems. The first, after 25 minutes, came from Ken Hodgkisson, recording

only his second goal of the season. A low George Meek centre went to Ray Wiggin, who turned the ball to Ken Hodgkisson for him to place round the goalkeeper.

Ken also had a hand in the second goal after 62 minutes when he flicked a clearance on to Graham Matthews. The inside right took the ball some 20 yards before shooting in, a shot which gave the goalkeeper little chance.

These two goals brought Walsall their first Saturday home league win of the season and we look forward to them repeating it today when we receive Luton at the start of this second half of the season. After all we have a score to settle with them, a little matter of a 1-0 defeat in the opening match of the season.

But if the first team chose to end their losing ways the Reserves ended their winning one when losing 5-4 to Wolves, the first time they have lost this season.

Today it is hoped that the new "Saddler's Song" will be heard. I will not steal Bernard Johnston's thunder and leave you to read all about it in the Supporters' Club notes.

GORDON TURNER. Came to Luton as a Wing half upon his demob from the Navy. The Town's leading goalscorer for eight seasons, he is a skilled player with a tremendous shot.

THOMAS McKECHNIE. Born Glasgow and came here direct from Rob Roy (Scotland) at the end of season 1960-61.
