From the Manager's Office

Today we welcome our old friends "The Hatters" from Luton who this season have had a very lean time indeed but have recently shown improved form; but come to that so have we!! The point I want to make is that this match will be a hard one and I am sure that no one more than our own players realise this. Whatever the result, I am sure that it will be a clean and exciting one.

Talking of our visitors makes one think how uncertain this game can be and how one can never foresee the future, because it was in the 1958-59 season that Luton Town were a First Division team and were in the Cup Final at Wembley. I am sure that they are determined to regain those honours just as quickly as they lost them.

Speaking of the Cup Final, I am sure that we are pleased to see our near neighbours West Ham United have reached the semi-final. Personally my pleasure will be in the knowledge that all the team, with the exception of Byrne, Standen and Brabrook, were with me from the age of fifteen when I was manager of the club. It proves the wisdom of having a strong youth section and that clubs in more ways than one are patient with the players and manager.

Whilst we are still on the youth theme it was nice to see Derek Ewing, our sixteen-year-old winger, play for the reserves and that he notched a goal. There are more promising youngsters coming along and this is proved by the fact that our young side in the Borough Combination are second from top, one point behind the leaders, and have three games in hand. I am sure that the directors are wise to encourage this important part of our organisation.

Incidentally, for your information the three leading goalscorers for our Borough Combination side are Mickey Wright (17 years old) 21 goals; Chris Barnard (16 years old) 20 goals and another youngster Frank Dudley (age ??) 17 goals. (Frank, as you know, is our old player who is manager of our youth section).

Our point last Saturday at Notts County was hard fought for, but with a little more accuracy from our forwards we could have had two points. It was left to Terry Bradbury to come to their and our rescue to head a great goal in the closing minutes. But Terry has told the forwards that he does not intend to do it every match, so the forwards have told him that they will see to it that he can now rest on his laurels.



LUTON TOWN

RON BAYNHAM. Has been with Luton Town since 1951. Was secured from Worcester City. He has represented England on several occasions. Played for the Football League on two occasions and also for England "B" Team versus Yugoslavia "B". Was a member of the F.A. Touring team to South America in 1959.

JOHN BRAMWELL. Joined Luton in October 1960 from Everton and has proved a very capable player worthy to be considered for International honours. Played at Wing-half on several occasions last season, proving equally successful.

MATT BRENNAN. Signed from Scottish Club Glasgow St. Roch, in June 1962 on the recommendation of our old player David Hutchison. Called in to First Team service towards the end of last season when he showed much promise for the future.

CRAHAN CALEB. This youngster signed as an Apprentice Footballer for us in December 1961, although he has 3 "A" levels. Settled down very well and showed such promise that he was offered full Professional Registration in April 1963.

FRED JARDINE. Born in Edinburgh. Played for Dundee for 2 seasons before coming to Luton at the end of season 1960-61. Has shown promise since he arrived here.

MARK LOWNDS. Signed from Durham in January 1960. Became full-timer on completion of his apprenticeship with a local firm. Is a wing-half who likes to get on with the game. A tireless worker.

ALAN McBAIN. Born in Aberdeen. Played for Carlisle last season when he attracted the Manager's attention. Transferred to Luton in exchange for J. Lornie and A. Ross. A very sound and capable defender.

THOMAS McKECHNIE. Born Glasgow and came here direct from Rob Roy (Scotland) at the end of season 1960-61. Played consistently in the First Team the past two seasons, except when injury prevented him from playing.

DAVID PACEY. Born in Luton, signed for the Club in 1956. Has played for the F.A. versus the R.A.F. and was also a member of the England under 23 team against Germany and Italy. Very strong player with a liking for getting among the goalscorers.

HARRY WALDEN. Joined Luton from Kettering in January 1961 and stepped straight into the First Team. Severely injured at a crucial part of last season's programme which prevented him from taking any further part in the struggle against relegation. It is hoped he has lost none of his skill as a result of that injury.
