Club Notes

AT long last, it would seem, we are approaching the turn in a long lane that has brought so much disappointment.

Coupled with an improvement by the team which has brought them 11 points out of the last 16, is the fact that the results being achieved by other teams in the relegation zone, are beginning to favour us.

With the combination of our win at Southend last Saturday and the defeats this week of Barnsley, Notts County and Crewe, comes the gleam of light and hope for which we have been waiting so long.

Now, we hold a real chance of avoiding the drop to the Fourth Division although everybody connected with the club knows that it will be a real struggle in the remaining weeks of the season.

Today, we welcome Peterborough Utd. who are comparative newcomers to the Football League, but who have accomplished a great deal since they left the Midland League.

Although we have entertained their Reserves, this is the first time their senior team has paid a visit to Kenilworth Road and we are hopeful of going one step better than we did at Peterborough in November when the result was a goalless draw.

After recent victories, it would seem reasonable to assume that we shall have a bigger than average crowd today, especially as Peterborough, back on the success trail with three consecutive victories, are bringing a following.

Congratulations to the Youth Team in winning their way through to the last eight of the F.A. Youth Cup by over-

coming Stoke City after a gruelling match on Wednesday evening when 1,828 people paid £112 to see them.

Next opponents will be the strong Queens Park Rangers team, who will visit Kenilworth Road on Monday week, kick-off 7.30 p.m.

If we win this, then we are due to meet Swindon Town, who beat Arsenal this week, in a two-legged affair. In the other Semi-Final, Manchester United take on Manchester City and it would be a great feather in the caps of the youngsters and of the people who look after them, if Luton could win their way to the final.

Meanwhile, there is another final to be contested on Monday when the youths go to Highbury to meet Arsenal in the first leg of the South East Counties League Cup Final.

The Bobbers Stand and Supporters Club are running a coach, so that the team will not lack for encouragement.

The coach will leave at 5.45 p.m., fare 8/- and anyone wishing to go should contact Ken Emerton at the Pools Office today.

Second leg will be played here on Good Friday and this match should set up a new record so far as crowd figures for a youth match are concerned.

With so many arriving at the ground at the last moment, a queue developed at the Kenilworth Road end last Wednesday, but three more turnstiles were opened quickly and, for future matches, more entrances will be available.

Returning to the first team, they have a tough week ahead of them with visits to Bristol to meet the Rovers on Tuesday

Morris Emmerson (goalkeeper). 20 years of age, Ex Middlesbrough and schoolboy International.

Oliver Hopkins (right back). A stalwart at Peterborough. Came from Barnsley. Fast and brilliant in the air.

Graham Sissons (left back). Came from Birmingham City for large fee. Can play centre half, but has developed into a fine full back.

Brian Jackson (right half). Previously with Port Vale, successful as wing half last season, but earlier this season reverted to his original position at outside right.

Frank Rankmore (centre half). Signed from Cardiff City, where he was regular first team centre half for three seasons. Only 24 years of age. 6 ft. 1½ ins. tall. Has Welsh Under 23 caps. A strong defender.

Anthony Moulden (outside right). Late of Rochdale. 20 years of age. Tireless, and always has an eye for a goal.

Roy Horobin (inside right). A scheming inside forward. Late of West Bromwich and Notts County. A great striker of the ball.
