PEN PICTURES OF SOME OF THE PLAYING STAFF OF LUTON TOWN

Ron Bayham (Goalkeeper). Has been with Luton Town since 1951. Was secured from Worcester City. He has represented England on several occasions. Played for the Football League on two occasions and also for England "B" Team versus Yugoslavia "B". Was a member of the F.A. Touring team to South America in 1959.

John Bramwell (Full Back). Joined Luton in October, 1960 from Everton and has proved a very capable player worthy to be considered for International honours. Played at Wing-half on several occasions last season, proving equally successful.

Graham Caleb (Centre-half). This youngster signed as an Apprentice Footballer for us in December, 1961, although he has three "A" levels. Settled down very well and showed such promise that he was offered full Professional Registration in April, 1963.

Robin Chandler (Centre Forward). A local lad who made a name playing for his County Youth Team. Also holds England Schoolboy caps. Is apprenticed to a local firm and thus is still a part-time player.

Alan Clarke (Wing Half). Another local lad who has played considerably well since he joined us as an Amateur in the 1957-58 Season. Signed as a part-time Professional in October, 1961.

Alan Daniel (Full Back). A player of considerable promise who gained a place in the First team last season. Signed Professional for Luton in January, 1958, when 18. Son of Mel Daniel who played for us during and immediately after the war.

Michael Fairchild (Outside Right). Came to Luton from Lowestoft in November, 1960. Can be brilliant at times which makes us have great hopes for the future.

Gordon Fincham (Centre Half). Transferred from Leicester to Plymouth 4 years ago and then to Luton in July, 1963. Is the dominating Centre Half we hope will strengthen our defence



Mark Lownds (Wing Half). Signed from Durham in January, 1960. Became full-timer on completion of his apprenticeship with a local firm. Is a wing half who likes to get on with the game. A tireless worker.

Alan McBain (Full Back). Born in Aberdeen. Played for Carlisle last season when he attracted the Manager's attention. Transferred to Luton in exchange for J. Lornie and A. Ross. A very sound and capable defender.

Thomas McKechnie (Inside Forward). Born Glasgow and came here direct from Rob Roy (Scotland) at the end of season 1960-61. Played consistently in the First Team the past two seasons, except when injury prevented him from playing.

David Pacey (Wing Half). Born in Luton, signed for the Club in 1956. Has played for the F.A. versus the R.A.F. and was also a member of the England under 23 team against Germany and Italy. Very strong player with a liking for getting among the goalscorers.

Gordon Riddick (Inside Forward). Turned Professional in April, 1961 following a short period of Apprenticeship. Tall, with good ball control and a very good shot, much is expected of this lad as he gains more experience. Has already made several First Team appearances.

Gareth Salisbury (Inside Forward). Played for Norwich City last season. When we found he was not being retained we immediately jumped in and signed him. Can play Forward or Half Back, but prefers to be up front.

Barry Scott (Wing Half). Born in Durham and on coming South, played for Hatfield. Was signed by us early in 1962. His progress last season in the Football Combination side augurs well for the future.

Harry Walden (Outside Right). Joined Luton from Kettering in January, 1961 and stepped straight into the First Team. Severely injured at a crucial part of last season's programme which prevented him from taking any further part in the struggle against relegation. It is hoped he has lost none of his skill as a result of that injury.
