Club Notes

WHEN the fixtures for this season were published last summer, we noted that our old friends from Watford were to be our last visitors and, naturally, hoped that this would be a significant occasion, with us making a challenge for promotion.

In the event, it has been Watford who have made the running in the higher positions and they come here today with a chance of winning their way to the Second Division, but dependant on Coventry's result against Colchester Utd.

On the other hand, we have had a season of struggle, relieved by a brilliant run of seven matches without defeat which has netted us 12 points.

When the final whistle went at Oldham on Wednesday, with two more points collected by means of Mark Lowndes' second goal of the season, officials and players alike felt that a tremendous weight had been lifted off them.

True, we are not in the clear yet, but the results of today's games could combine to see us high and dry when they come out this evening.

Both at Oldham and Colchester last Saturday, the forwards had some bad luck in front of goal which kept both matches in a state of tension until the end.

This was most marked in the first half against the Essex club during which the team played some polished football, but gained a cruel run of the ball in front of goal, otherwise, the other decisive point could have been firmly in the bag by half-time.

Twice at Oldham, the ball was cleared off the goal-line in circumstances which produced claims from our players of

goals, but thanks to the dogged, determined work of the defence, that single goal was enough to bring us two golden points.

The last three matches, all away from home, have produced five points, a performance that is all the more amazing in that we had to wait so long for our first away win of the season.

Tribute to the way in which the defence has buckled down to its task and its general soundness under pressure is contained in the fact that in those 270 minutes of football, only two goals have been conceded and that is a feat of great merit in itself.

But the recovery has been marked by a tremendous resurgence in fighting spirit and the results, in turn, have increased the confidence of the team as a whole which is now looking forward to decidedly better things in the new season.

Undoubtedly, after their years in the higher circles, there had to be a settling in period to the different style of play needed in the Third Division.

Unfortunately, this lasted longer than we had hoped, but through all the trials and tribulations, a valuable lesson has been learned on which we hope to build for next season.

Today marks the first visit to Kenilworth Road of Watford in a League match for over 25 years and it is perhaps sad that such important issues to both clubs hang on the result because there has always been the friendliest feeling between the two clubs.

PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

Pat Jennings (goalkeeper). Pat is 18 and joined the Club from Newry Town in May 1963. He represented Northern Ireland in the International Youth Tournament final at Wembley.

Ken Nicholas (right back). Born at Northampton, Ken came to Watford in May 1958 after a spell with Arsenal. Is in partnership with Tony Gregory in a sports outfitting business.

Bryn R. Jones (left back). Bryn came to Watford in November last after services with Newport, Bournemouth and Northampton.

Ron Crisp (right half). A former Dulwich Hamlet amateur, Ron became professional in 1961 when he left the Army. Started his career as an inside forward but is now playing at wing half.

Sammy Chung (centre half). Appointed as a coach last close season, Sammy is doing a fine job coaching the younger players and assisting young footballers at his evening coaching school. Born in Abingdon, Sammy came to Watford from Norwich in June 1957.

Brian Owen (left half). A former apprentice, Brian signed professional forms in July 1962 and made his debut in the first team at the end of last season. Also toured Switzerland with a Football Association youth team.

George Catleugh (left half). At the end of this season George will have completed 10 years service with the Club and at the time of writing has made 280 first team appearances despite missing most of last season through breaking a leg.

Ronald Spelman (outside right). Signed from Bournemouth this season, was previously with Northampton. Born in Norwich.

Jim McAnearney (inside right). Jim was transferred to Watford from Plymouth Argyle in November 1963. His previous club was Sheffield Wednesday for whom his brother, Tom, still plays.

Charlie Livesey (centre forward). After playing for Southampton, Chelsea and Gillingham, Charlie came to Watford in October 1962.

Ken Oliver (inside left). Signed for Watford in July 1963 and in his three previous seasons at Barnsley created a reputation as a goal scorer. Born at Pelton in Co. Durham.

George Harris (outside left). Born in London, George played for Chelsea and Newport County before coming to Watford in April 1962. In his 42 appearances last season he scored 14 goals.
