

PEN PICTURES OF LUTON TOWN A.F.C.

RON BAYNHAM (Goalkeeper). 6ft. 1in. 12st. 9lbs. Born in Birmingham. He has been with the club since he was signed from Worcester City in 1951. He has gained his full international cap with England and played for them on several occasions.

ALAN McBAIN (Right Back). 5ft. 8ins. 11st. 3lbs. Born in Aberdeen. He attracted the Manager's attention whilst he was playing with Carlisle United and was transferred to Luton in exchange for J. Lornie and A. Ross. A very sound and capable defender.

JOHN BRAMWELL (Left Back). 6ft. 12st. 13lbs. Born in Wigan. Joined the club in October 1960 from Everton, and has proved a player worthy to be considered for international honours. He played at wing-half on several occasions last season.

DAVID PACEY (Right Half). 5ft. 10ins. 11st. 7lbs. Born in Luton, and signed for the club in 1956. He won honours when selected for the England under 23's team against Germany and Italy. A strong player with a liking to be among the goal-scorers.

GORDON FINCHAM (Centre Half). 6ft. 2ins. 13st. Born at Hornchurch. He was signed from Plymouth in 1963, after having previous experience with Leicester City. A dominating centre half back.

MARK LOWNDS (Left Half). 5ft. 11ins. 12st. 6lbs. Born in Sunderland. Signed from Durham in January 1960. He became a full-timer on completion of his Apprenticeship. A tireless worker.


DAVID PLEAT (Outside Right). 5ft. 10ins. 12st. Joined the club from Nottingham Forest on 26th August who are his only other league club. A former Youth International who played in the same team as O'Rourke and Whittaker.

THOMAS McKECHNIE (Inside Right). 6ft. 1in. 12st. 12lbs. Born in Glasgow. He came to the club direct from Rob Roy (Scotland) at the end of Season 1960-61. Played constantly in the team for the past three seasons.

JOHN O'ROURKE (Centre Forward). 5ft. 9ins. 11st. Born at Northampton. Formerly with Arsenal and Chelsea from where he was signed on a free transfer in December 1963. He then scored 22 goals in 23 appearances for the club. An England Youth International.

JOHN REID (Inside Left). Previously played for Bradford and Northampton to whom the club paid a substantial transfer fee in November 1963. He is a tireless and energetic worker.

RAY WHITTAKER (Outside Left). 5ft. 5ins. 9st. 10lbs. A Londoner from Bow, his only other club being Arsenal. He gained England Youth International honours with John O'Rourke in 1962 and 1963, and joined the club in March of this year, going straight into the first team and keeping his place.

KEEPING IT IN THE FAMILY!

That fascinating subject of footballing families is revived with the fact that Queens Park Rangers are giving a trial to 16-year-old Frank Brady, younger brother of their Eire international centre-half Ray, and right-back Pat.

If the youngster makes the grade that could mean Rangers could field three brothers, but it would not be the first time this has happened.

Doncaster Rovers at one time had four Keetley brothers on their books and three of them Joe, Tom and Harold were in the forward line on one occasion in a Third North match.

The famous family Milburn had three brothers John, James and George as full-backs with Leeds United for a couple of seasons in the late thirties.


And what about this for a family record? When Ireland played England and Wales in 1933-4 season the half-back line consisted of John Jones (Linfield), Sam Jones (Distillery and Blackpool) and the third member of the line was Billy Mitchell of Chelsea, who was their brother-in-law!

Brothers have played together in international teams several times but something of a record was achieved by Wales in 1955 when they had two sets of brothers in their team against Ireland—Ivor and Len Allchurch, and John and Mervyn Charles.

The three brothers Jack—David, Donald and Robert—not only played together for Plymouth Argyle but all moved to Eolton Wanderers with which team David scored the first-ever Cup final goal at Wembley to help Wanderers win the Cup.

There are instances of sons following in father's footballing footsteps like Pat Delaney, Motherwell right-back who is the son of Manchester United's famous flying Scottish winger Jimmy, and Gordon Milne, Liverpool and England half-back is the son of Preston's manager and former North End half-back, and Stan Charlton, Leyton Orient's right-back whose dad was a right-back at Rochdale at one time.

And there have been cases where father and son played together in the same team just as Alex Herd and son David did for Stockport County in the Third Division in 1951, and George Eastham, then player-manager, and son George did with Ards in the Irish League in 1954-5.






