### Club Notes

WHILE there was natural disappointment that we did not collect both points from the home match with Port Vale on Wednesday and so missed a chance to take over the leadership, we feel that the game offered plenty of excitement and entertainment for our biggest crowd of the season.

That enthusiasm for football has been aroused in the town again, there can be no doubt and we hope to see another attendance running into five figures today.

Reflecting on Wednesday evening's match, there can be no doubt that we did not enjoy a fair share of the luck that was going.

Twice in the first half, goal-worthy efforts were stopped by the woodwork and had either of those counted, then the result might have been very different.

At the same time, it has to be admitted that we could have used more thrust in front of goal, but we are hoping that will be remedied this afternoon when John O'Rourke whose troublesome ankle has kept him out of all but two matches this season, returns to the team.

Unfortunately, a late decision ruled him out of the match with Port Vale and we can only trust that he will come through with flying colours today and thus be available for the return game with Port Vale at Vale Park on Monday.

Already, we have had two hard tussles with this opposition and there is no reason to assume that the next meeting will be any less testing.

Exeter, we welcome as old friends of our pre-war Division III (South) days since when the paths of the clubs have

crossed only once, in 1960, when we were narrow winners of an F.A. Cup tie at St. James's Park.

Now, Exeter are sampling Third Division football again after having had a spell in the Fourth and they have not had the best of luck in these opening weeks because injuries have deprived them of their leading scorer, Alan Banks, formerly of Liverpool and Cambridge City, and full back, Cecil Smyth.

So far, they have collected only three points out of 10 which perhaps indicates that they are finding the going heavy, but these are early days yet, and they include several talented players in their line-up.

In the second round of the League Cup we have been fortunate enough to have ground advantage against First Division opposition in Aston Villa and the match will be played on Wednesday week, kick-off 7.30 p.m.

Usual first team prices will be charged and it should be noted that this is one of the occasions on which everyone pays.

Reserved seats will be available at 7/6 and season ticket holders can obtain their usual seats by application at the club's offices.

On the previous evening, we have arranged to send a team to Chesham to play the first match under their new floodlighting system and had hoped to be able to send something approaching a full strength side, but this will not be possible now that the game with the Villa is on.
