### Club Notes

ALTHOUGH we lost our interest in the Football League Cup through the only goal against Aston Villa on Wednesday night, we feel that even the most severe critics of the club will agree that the team put up a tremendous fight and were unlucky not to force a replay.

In the closing stages of the first half and for much of the time after the interval, Villa's defence was at action stations, but the all-important goal just would not come.

While a replay would have complicated the issue from the point of view of the fixture list which is heavily crowded during the next fortnight, we are sorry to lose interest in a competition which is growing in popular appeal.

Now, it is back to the hunt for League points and the particularly arduous programme that awaits the team during the next 17 days when, including today's meeting with Peterborough United, they have to face six matches, four of which, consecutively, are away.

It is as tough an assignment as could be imagined, especially in view of the travelling that the players will be called upon to do, starting on the day following the visit of Carlisle United next Thursday which will be our last home match until October 17th when Hull City are due here.

Peterborough are a progressive club who after having an outstanding record in non-League football, quickly made their mark on election to the Football League.

Promotion from Division IV came their way and they have their sights fixed on an even higher grade of football. In pursuance of that, they have spent a good deal of money on established stars like the Internationals, Derek Dougan and Vic Crowe, and they should prove to be most attractive opposition today.

Their latest signing is Nigel Sims, who kept goal for Aston Villa in the 1957 Cup Final when Manchester United, handicapped by an injury to their own goalkeeper, Ray Wood, were beaten by 2-1.

Sims, one of the most experienced goalkeepers in the country, was given a free transfer by Villa last season and went to Canada where he played for the champions and cup-winners, Toronto City. Since his return, at least one other club has been angling for his services, but Peterborough's offer was the most acceptable to him and he is due to make his first appearance for his new club today.

Another player making a debut today is our own Tony Knights who, although he has played for us in two League Cup-ties will be having his first chance in a League match since joining the club during the summer from Grimsby Town. Called upon to deputise for the injured Mark Lownds on Wednesday, he gave a creditable performance which fully entitled him to another chance.

Next Thursday evening (kick-off 7.30) brings new opposition for Luton in the shape of Carlisle United, who won promotion from Division IV last season.

## PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

**N. Sims** (goalkeeper). Most recent signing having joined Peterborough last Thursday. First club was Wolverhampton Wanderers, transferred to Aston Villa for whom he played for 8 seasons. Since leaving Villa has played in Canada for Toronto City.

**T. Singleton** (right back). Born in Blackpool. Played for Blackpool Town team, Lanes. Youth team, and England Youth at Villa Park. Joined Peterborough in July 1962.

**G. Birks** (left back). Born in Sheffield, joined Wednesday when 16. Made his First Division debut against West Brom. 3 years later. Signed by Peterborough in May 1964.

**V. Crowe** (wing half and Captain). Signed this year from Aston Villa. Has made over 380 first team appearances for Villa since his debut in 1954. He was capped for Wales in 1958 and has 18 International caps. Has captained Wales and also Villa team.

**J. Walker** (centre half). Born in Sheffield. Played for Sheffield boys and Yorkshire boys. Signed for Sheffield United, then transferred to Huddersfield Town. Now in eighth year with Peterborough United.

**F. Rankmore** (wing half). Formerly with Cardiff City where he gained Under 23 honours for Wales. Left Cardiff to join Posh in August 1963. Played in every League game during last season.

**R. Barnes** (outside right). Played for Bolton schoolboys. On leaving school played for Lomax F.C. in Lancashire Combination. Signed professional for Blackpool at 17 years of age.

**T. Moulden** (inside forward). Played for Bolton schoolboys. Signed for Blackburn Rovers as an amateur. At 17 joined Bury as a professional, staying with them for three years, then went to Rochdale. Came to Peterborough in November 1962.

**D. Dougan** (centre forward). Born in Belfast. Previously played for Distillery, Portsmouth, Blackburn and Aston Villa before signing for Peterborough in June 1963. Honours — 3 Schoolboy caps, 3 Youth caps, 3 Amateur caps, 13 Full Irish International caps, Full cap on World Cup against Czechoslovakia 1960. Cup final for Blackburn against Wolves, lost 3-0.

**P. Deakin** (inside forward). Signed for Bolton Wanderers in 1954. Played over 100 First Division games. Also qualified as a school teacher specializing in Physical Education.

**I. Crawford** (outside left). Born Edinburgh. Previous Clubs: Hearts, West Ham and Scunthorpe. 2 Under 23 caps, Scottish Cup winners medal, 2 League Cup winners medals, 2 League Championship medals. Joined Posh in July 1964.
