### Club Notes

AFTER an exhausting programme of four away matches in varying and far-flung parts of the country, the team returns to Kenilworth Road this afternoon with old Second Division rivals Hull City as the opposition.

That string of away games began promisingly enough with a point taken from each of Grimsby and Carlisle, good performances in any circumstances, but the results tailed off at Workington and Mansfield.

In the match at Workington the team did enough to earn a goalless draw, only for the vital decider to come four minutes from the end from what looked suspiciously like an offside position.

There was less ground for complaint about the result at Mansfield where the defence which has been having a great deal to do recently, put up another brave fight, and felt aggrieved about the award of the second goal which finally finished our hopes.

That there has not been a victory in any of the last 10 matches makes it all the more important that the series of matches which begins today—and four of the next five are at home—should bring their full reward.

Unfortunately, we have been dealt a hard blow by being deprived of the services of John O'Rourke for at least the next five matches because of the trouble he has been experiencing with his right ankle which has now been immobilised in plaster.

That injury dates back to the first match of the season at Brentford and although he has played frequently since, he has not shown his old confidence and, as a result, goals have not been coming so frequently from him as was expected.

This fact has had a great deal to do with the disappointing run of results and the problem has been to try to find more punch in front of goal.

This, of course, is increased immeasurably by O'Rourke's enforced absence and his place in the middle goes today to Robin Chandler, who has been on the club's books for a long time after having attracted attention as a schoolboy star.

In the last couple of seasons, Chaudler has been mostly in the background of the reserve team, but he has pressed home his claims with his recent scoring feats. Last Saturday, he scored both the goals that beat Coventry Reserves 2-1 and followed up this with a hat-trick on Monday for the 'A' team against Bury Town.

In his previous outing for the 'A' team he found the net twice and his impressive record of seven goals in three matches made him the logical choice as O'Rourke's deputy.

If he can reveal similar form in the senior team, then he will remove much of the anxiety that is felt about the immediate position.

Managed by the former England and Everton wing-half star, Cliff Britton, Hull are an ambitious club who are all out to regain their former status.

## PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

**Maurice Swan** (goalkeeper). Born in Dublin. Had three seasons with Cardiff City before being transferred to Hull City in June 1963.

**Andy Davidson** (right back). Joined the club in 1948 and is the perfect example of a good club man. Despite suffering a broken leg on three occasions fought his way back to fitness and the 1st XI. The only 'ever-present' in the side last season. Born in Douglas Water, Lanarkshire.

**Brian Garvey** (left back). Born in Hull, had amateur and part-time service with the club before turning full-time professional in 1961. Can occupy most of the defence positions.

**Les Collinson** (right half). Served the club as an amateur from 1953 to 1956 when he turned full-time professional. Another of the Tigers local born players.

**Mike Milner** (centre half). Joined Hull City in 1955 as an amateur, became a part-time professional in 1957 and signed full-time last season. Born in Hull.

**Gerry Summers** (left half). Signed by the Tigers in April from Sheffield United and showed his class from the start. A player with great ability.

**Ron Young** (outside right). Born in Gateshead. Signed for the Tigers in August 1963 and though still a teenager is showing great promise.

**Billy Wilkinson** (inside right). Was signed full time after having trials with Hull City and after making his 1st XI debut last season in October. Held his place to complete 33 1st XI matches and scored 16 goals.

**Chris Chilton** (centre forward). During the close season celebrated his 21st birthday and already has four seasons of League football behind him. Always prominent in the Tiger scoring records he topped the list for the club last season with 27 goals. Born at Sproatley near Hull.

**Ray Henderson** (inside left). Was with Middlesbrough before being transferred to Hull City in June 1961. Had 43 1st XI matches last season and scored 11 goals. Born in Wallsend.

**John McSeveny** (outside left). Came to Hull City from Newport County in 1961. Has played in goal when his team mate was injured. 33 1st XI appearances last season and scored 10 goals. Born in Shotts, Scotland.
