Club Notes

SINCE the last first team programme was issued, there has certainly been an eventful period. Following the resignation of Bill Harvey, the team goes on to the field today for the first time without a manager.

However, this is not the first time in our history that a sub-committee of Directors has been in charge and the Chairman, Mr. Tom Hodgson, thinks that it may be a happy omen that the last time it occurred, the club went on to the Cup Final.

While that may be a little more than wishful thinking, it is a fact that confidence in the camp has been restored to some extent by two consecutive victories.

A fortnight ago against today's opposition, Southend United, the team ended their long run without a victory and, at the same time qualified for the second round of the F.A. Cup in which we will be at home to Gillingham next Saturday.

Last Saturday, two late goals at Reading gave us our first League victory, either at home or away, since September 5th, and a further success today will send hopes soaring that we shall be able to go into the hat on Monday week for the coveted third round draw in which we shall hope to land a "plum."

When there are departures, there must be replacements and we are glad to welcome back to the fold this week, Charlie Watkins, who has come in to re-inforce the training staff.

Most supporters will remember him as a stylish wing-half who joined us from Glasgow Rangers way back in the 1948-49 season and who stayed with us until we won promotion to the First Division in 1955.

A cheerful character who was always ready to do a stint at inside-forward when the necessity arose, Charlie played at inside-left in the match at Doncaster when we finally clinched our promotion bid with a 3-0 victory on the final day of a memorable season.

Since then, he has had a varied career, including a spell in South Africa, coaching engagements with three senior amateur clubs, a period as trainer to Norwich City, and a shop at Streatley.

His general know how, including his deep knowledge of physio-therapy should be a decided asset to the club and we bid him a warm welcome back to the club.

From the way in which Southend played here a fortnight ago, we know that we have a tough job on our hands this afternoon, but hope that the last two results achieved have brought a new spirit of confidence to the players who can be relied upon to fight until the end.

Season ticket holders and others who need stand seats for next week's Cup-tie, should note that these will be on sale before and after today's match at 7/6 each. Gillingham have taken their full quota and are expecting to bring a following which will run well into four figures and which will give a welcome boost to the figures at the turnstiles.

Because the Government have decreed that December 28th will not be a public holiday and Watford have discovered that at least two of their biggest firms in the town will be working that day, the kick-off time for our match with them at Vicarage Road has been put back from 3 p.m. to 7.30 p.m.
