### Club Notes

AFTER last week's disappointing display by the team, let us be optimistic and hope for a better result in today's F.A. Cup tie with Gillingham, who are making their first appearance on this ground for well over a quarter of a century.

However, with gates at the present low level and the general need for more financial support, it is vitally necessary that we should qualify for a coveted place in the third round with the hope of landing a plum pairing.

Obviously, the players are acutely aware of this, as acutely as they are disappointed at the way in which things have gone for them this season and they can be relied upon to give 100 per cent effort to bring about the result we are all hoping for.

There has been a stepping up of the training routine since the changes on the administrative side and extra training in the afternoon has been ordered in an effort to bring about results more in keeping with the traditions of the club.

Naturally, there have been changes for today's vital match and all we can hope is that they will work and that the team will be able to re-discover the form of the early days of the season when we all had high hopes that something tangible would be achieved.

Since Gillingham last played here, they have had a spell out of the Football League, but returned via the Fourth Division from which they gained promotion last season.

Managed by Freddie Cox, who was probably last on this ground when he played on the wing for Arsenal in a sensational sixth round match in March,

1952, they have been welded into a hard-fighting, difficult to beat combination.

Of their efficiency, our team had first hand knowledge a few weeks ago when they went down 5-0 on the ground of the Kent club, but mistakes in defence were made on that occasion which are unlikely to be repeated today.

Feature of Gillingham playing staff is that it includes six players who were formerly with Portsmouth and two from Bournemouth, both clubs with whom Mr. Cox spent spells as manager.

Without any doubt at all, he has welded them into a most workmanlike hard combination and we will do well to avoid a second meeting.

Should that be necessary, it will be at Priestfield Stadium next Wednesday, kick-off 7.30. Presumably, Gillingham will be bringing our allocation of stand tickets with them and if this match ends in a draw, they will be on sale at the club's offices immediately afterwards.

Wednesday will see the visit to Kenilworth Road of Southampton Reserves who would have been here today but for the Cup tie and the kick-off will be at 7.30 p.m.

Before that, our Juniors have an important meeting in the F.A. Youth Cup with Norwich City on this ground on Monday evening and we are hoping to survive this hurdle and emulate our run in this competition of last season when we reached the last eight.

Unfortunately, because of the age factor, we had to re-build almost from scratch, but now have got together a team that has improved considerably since the early days of the season.
