IF a somewhat jubilant note can be detected in these notes this week, then supporters will probably consider it understandable in view of the way in which things are going in the F.A. Cup.

After two hard battles with Southend United and Gillingham, we reached the coveted place in the third round and will have the pleasure of meeting Sunderland here on January 9th in a match that has already begun to stir the imagination of the fans.

Sunderland, of course, are old friends and rivals of ours from our palmer days and although they were one of the teams who pushed us deeper into relegation trouble at the end of the season before last, their record at Kenilworth Road makes by no means happy reading for them.

Several times they crashed heavily here and if our lads are in the indomitable mood of last Saturday, then they will certainly give the Division I team a run for their money.

Tickets are being issued only for the seating accommodation at 7/6 and 6/- and there is evidence already that there will be a considerable demand for them.

Enquiries have been received from quite far afield and tickets will be available by personal application at the Club's Offices, or through the post (remittance and stamped, addressed envelope, please) from the middle of next week.

Season ticket holders are reminded that they must claim their usual seats by Wednesday, January 6th, after which date, no guarantee can be given that tickets will be available.

Sunderland have had a far from happy return to the First Division, through their entire lack of success away from home. Probably, their biggest blow before they began their new career was the loss of their manager, Alan Brown, to Sheffield Wednesday.

After a difficult period during which several big names were mentioned in connection with the job, the former England and Middlesbrough full back, George Hardwick, has now taken over and they are hoping that his influence will be the start of better things.

Should a replay be necessary, it will be at Roker Park on Wednesday, 13th January, kick-off 7.30 p.m.

Unfortunately, the dreadful weather ruined our chances of a reasonable gate against Gillingham, but those who braved the rain saw a tremendously hard game in which no quarter was given and it produced its full quota of thrills.

Today, we welcome Brentford with whom we drew at Griffin Park on the first day of the season when, unfortunately, John O'Rourke damaged the ankle which has been so troublesome since.

However, there is better news of him because he has now been cleared by the hospital, will begin light training on Monday and he himself is hopeful that he will be playing again in three weeks time. PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

Chick Brodie (goalkeeper). Signed in November 1963 from Northampton Town for whom he won a Third Division championship medal. A Scot, previously with Gillingham, Aldershot and Wolves.

Allan Jones (right back). Signed at the start of last season from Liverpool, for whom he had First Division experience. Was so consistent that he missed only one match. A Welshman from Flint.

George Thomson (left back). A big money purchase from Everton in November 1963. Became link man in Brentford's 4-2-4 system. Was a left half with Hearts until losing this position to Dave Mackay. Scottish 'Under 23' International.

Mel Scott (right half). A five figure signing from Chelsea in March 1963. Former 'Under 23' English International who missed only two games last season.

Peter Gelson (centre half). Another former Junior, whose opportunities have been restricted by Mel Scott. Also plays at full back, wing half or inside forward.

Tommy Higginson (left half). Twice signed by Manager MacDonald, first for Kilmarnock. A tenacious ninety-minute player who was once a sprinter. Can, in an emergency, operate in the forward line.

Mark Lazarus (outside right). That soccer rarity, a goalscoring wingman. Mark began his professional career with Leyton Orient, moving to Queens Park Rangers and then to Wolves. Returned to Rangers and came to Griffin Park in January 1964 with George McLeod moving to Rangers in part exchange.

Jimmy Bloomfield (inside right). Jimmy signed for Brentford twelve years ago from amateur side Hayes, and soon captured the headlines. In 1954 he was transferred to Arsenal and five years later moved to Birmingham City for a £25,000 fee. Returned to Griffin Park in June.

Ian Lawther (centre forward). Irish International signed two weeks ago from Scunthorpe. Brentford's Chairman, Jack Dunnett, M.P. for Nottingham Central

completed his signing in the House of Commons. Previously with Sunderland and Blackburn.

Billy Cobb (inside left). Signed as a left half from Plymouth three months ago but has become a scoring inside forward with seven goals in his last four games. Previously with Notts Forest.

John Fielding (outside left). Can perform in any forward position but prefers inside right. Signed from Southport in March 1963 after a brilliant game against Brentford. Comes from Liverpool area.
