### Club Notes

TODAY, we give a warm welcome to our old friends and rivals, Watford, who so narrowly missed promotion last season but who are not enjoying the same measure of success this time.

When they came here for our last home game of last season, there was great interest in the match because Watford's promotion chance was still alive.

As a result, there was a crowd of 19,779, easily our best of the season and we hope that we shall get well into five figures today because recent attendances have been well below the economic mark.

Watford lost their manager, Bill McGarry to Ipswich Town and their new chief is Ken Furphy, who played right back against us at Workington, where he was player-manager.

In the event, Ken is still active because it was not long before he named himself for the same position in the Watford team, but he has not had an encouraging start to his new career because Watford are in a bad patch.

Not that that counts for much in a local derby such as we are staging today because in a meeting between such rivals, there is always the incentive to pull out a little extra if that is humanly possible.

At the time of writing these notes, necessarily early in the week because of the Christmas holidays, the composition of the respective teams was not known, but ours was expected to be little changed.

To lose by only 3-2 against Bristol Rovers at Eastville was not a bad

performance, especially as we would not have been flattered to have returned with a point.

As things turned out, the Rovers' style was better suited to the hard, frosty conditions than was ours, but we came away feeling that the better football had come from our lads and that no one could have complained had the result been a draw.

Supporters who intend travelling to Watford for the return game on Monday are reminded that the kick-off time has been altered to 7.30 p.m.

However, the start for the Reserves match with Watford on this ground the same day, remains unaltered at 3 p.m. At the moment, our Reserves are going great guns and they are in with a very continued inside front cover

We appeal to spectators on this ground to help cut out the stupid practice of throwing toilet rolls on to the pitch which caused the referee to threaten to stop play in our last home match with Brentford.

That our supporters were not responsible we are convinced, and that the trouble was caused by youths. Adults who are standing nearby can help considerably by remonstrating with the paper throwers. We do not want trouble on this ground and we intend to do everything within our power to stamp it out.

## PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

**Peter Goy** (goalkeeper). Peter joined the Vicarage Road staff in July 1964 after having served with Arsenal and Southend United. Peter is also a keen golfer.

**Ken Furphy** (full back). Recently became Player - Manager of the Club upon Bill McGarry leaving for Ipswich Town.

**John Williams** (full back). Signed professional for Watford on 17th birthday. Made his League debut last Saturday against Gillingham.

**Duncan Welbourne** (wing half). Duncan came from Grimsby Town in November last year and went straight into the first team owing to a number of injuries at that time. He had made 20 first team appearances before an injury at Shrewsbury put him out of action for the remainder of the season.

**Terry Mancini** (centre half). This is Terry's fourth season with Watford, having signed professional forms in July 1961. Born in London, Terry is a member of the famous boxing family.

**Bill Houghton** (half back). Bill was signed from Barnsley during the last close season for a five figure fee. He is a former England Youth International.

**Ron Spelman** (outside left). Ron came to Watford in September 1963 from Bournemouth having previously played for Northampton and Norwich.

**Jim McAnearney** (inside forward). Jim was born in Dundee and played for Sheffield Wednesday and Plymouth before coming to Watford in November 1963. In his 25 League appearances, Jim hit the net on eight occasions.

**Ron Saunders** (centre forward). Signed from Portsmouth in September for a fee of £15,000. Leading goal scorer for the Hampshire club for several seasons.

**Tommy Anderson** (inside forward). Rejoined Watford staff on a month's trial after a spell in Australia.

**George Harris** (outside left). Signed from Newport County in 1962, George is 23 years of age. Last year he played in every first team match and scored 16 goals.
